Effects of this medicine

This medicine keeps moisture of the skin to relieve symptoms of dry skin. It also accelerates blood flow of the applied area to relieve pain or swelling caused by vascular insufficiency.

It is usually used to treat asteatosis, keratodermia tylodes palmaris progressiva, chilblain, hypertrophic scar/keloid, pain and inflammatory disease caused by vascular insufficiency, posttraumatic swelling and pain, etc.

Before using this medicine, be sure to tell your doctor and pharmacist

- If you have previously experienced any allergic reactions (itch, rash, etc.) to any medicines.
- If you have a hemorrhagic blood disease (hemophilia, thrombocytopenia, purpura, etc).
- If you are a patient who are expected to have a serious result with slight bleeding.
- · If you are pregnant or breastfeeding.
- •If you are taking any other medicinal products. (Some medicines may interact to enhance or diminish medicinal effects. Beware of over-the-counter medicines and dietary supplements as well as other prescription medicines.)

Dosing schedule (How to take this medicine)

- In general, apply an appropriate amount of cream to the affected area, or apply the gauze previously spread with the cream to the affected area once to several times a day. Strictly follow the instructions.
- •Do not apply this medicine to your eyes, ulcer or erosion directly.
- If you miss a dose, apply a dose when you remembered that you missed a dose. You should never apply two doses at one time.
- ullet If you accidentally apply more than your prescribed dose, consult with your doctor or pharmacist.
- •Do not stop applying this medicine unless your doctor instructs you to do so.

Precautions while taking this medicine

Possible adverse reactions to this medicine

The most commonly reported adverse reactions include dermatitis, itch, redness, rash and hot flush. If any of these symptoms occur, consult with your doctor or pharmacist.

The symptoms described below are rarely seen as initial symptoms of the adverse reactions indicated in brackets. If any of these symptoms occur, stop taking this medicine and see your doctor immediately.
