Seed balls



Recipe

2 parts soil 5 parts clay

Mix thoroughly as you can

Method 1 (Wildflowers)

- Mix the wildflower seeds together
- · Mix in wildflower seeds and 1 part water
- · Mix until it is the consistency of modeling clay/play doe
- Roll into balls

Method 2 (Sunflowers)

- · Mix the clay and soil with 1 part water
- roll into balls
- Add 1-2 seeds per ball

Roll balls into the size of a large marble (approx. 1" in diameter) Set balls on a table to dry Best stored in a cardboard box (allows the mosture to evaporate)

Seed balls are ready to use when they are hard/firm

Timing

Spring is a great time to throw seed balls. Rain will trigger the seeds within the seed balls to start growing.

Throw into a sunny area.
