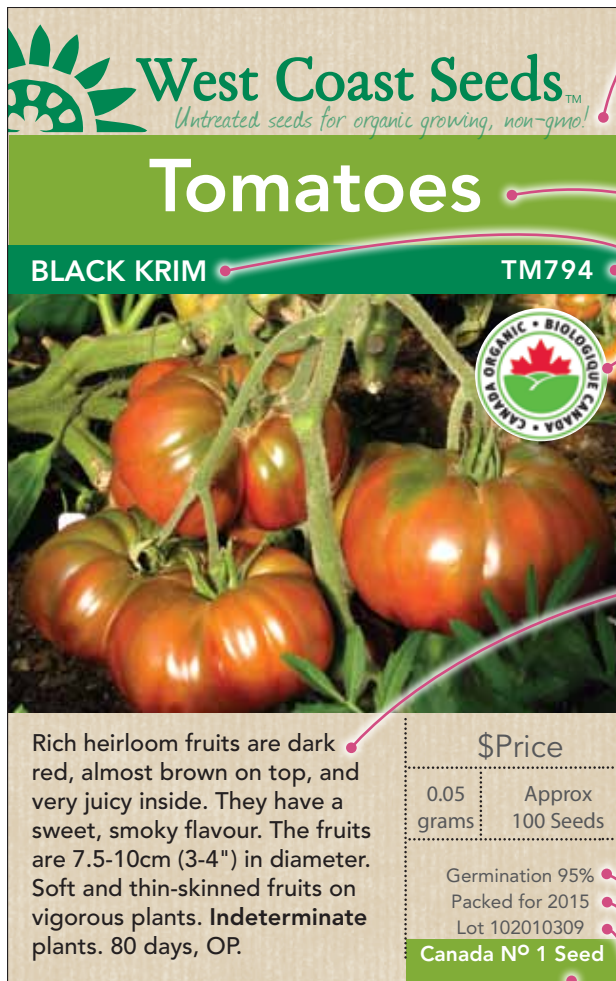

When the Certified Organic icon is indicated, the growers have certified their farms to be free of synthetic chemicals, and to meet criteria set out by organic certification bodies in Canada, US, and Europe.

Includes a guideline of approximate size and days to maturity. We indicate whether it is open pollinated (OP) or a Hybrid (F1). OP seeds are preferred for seed saving. Hybrid seeds are the product of cross-pollination between plants.
