

Addition Facts Pocket Games Lapbook



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Addition Facts Lapbook Instructions

This lapbook provides hand-on practice for addition facts 0+0 through 12+0 while providing lots of fun at the circus! All answers to these facts will have an answer of 12 or less.

Fact Cards are the cards that contain all of the addition facts 0+0 through 12+0. Once these are cut out, just keep them stored in your Family Storage Pockets until ready to use.

In folders 1 and 2, there are two different types of pockets:

- Family Storage Pockets
- Answer Pockets.

Family Storage Pockets are where you will keep your family cards when not in use. In this lapbook, cards that start with the same number are considered in the same family for example: 4+0, 4+1, 4+2, 4+3 and 4+4, etc. are in the same family-the 4 family.

Answer Pockets have a circus scene and a number (answer) on each. After your child figures out the answer on a fact card, he/she slides it into the correct answer pocket.

The various Lands-on activities in folder 3 are labeled on those activities. So, come on and enter into the Circus Big Top and let the learning begin!



How to fold and connect the folders for your lapbook.



1. Gather the number of folders required for your particular lapbook. You may use manila or colored ones.



2. Open up each folder and flatten it out.



3. Take the right side and fold it at the way over until the tab is ust before the middle crease in the folder. Do not overlap this crease with the tab.



4. Fold the left hand-side over just to the crease but not overlapping it. Your folder not has two flaps. We like to up a ruler down each fold to habe the fold neater and latter Do steps 3 and 4 to the remaining folders.



 It ke two of the folders and apply a generous amount of plue to their flaps. We recommend using Zip Dry Paper Glue.



6. Bring the flaps together and press so they stick together.



7. Do steps 5 and 6 to your remaining folders (if any).



8. We provide all of the mini-booklets for your lapbook. Just cut out, fold, and glue them into the folders. Refer to the booklet placement key or the actual mini-booklet page for placement of each mini-booklet.



Inside folder 2




Inside folder 3



Inside entire lapbook












Glue this page to front of closed lapbook







