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## Addition Facts Lapbook Instructions

This lapbook provides hand-on practice for addition facts $0+0$ through $12+0$ while providing lots of fun at the circus! All answers to these facts will have an answer of 12 or less.

Fact Cards are the cards that contain all of the addition facts $0+0$ through $12+0$. Once these are cut out, just keep them si ed jay your Family Storage Pockets until ready to use.

In folders 1 and 2, there are two different type 0 nockets:

## - Family Storage Pockets

- Answer Pockets.

Family Storage Pockets are where fou will keep your family cards when not in use. In this lapbeok, car/ that start with the same number are considered in the sam 1 miv for example: $4+0,4+1,4+2,4+3$ and $4+4$, etc. are in the sane family-the 4 family.

## How to fold and connect the folders for your lapbook.



1. Gather the number of folders required for your particular lapbook. You may use manila or colored ones.

2. Open up each folder and flatten it out.

3. Take $r$ righ side and fold it the way or until the tab is ust k, fo e the middle crease in
e fold . Do not overlap this crease with the tab.

4. Bring the flaps together and press so they stick together.
5. Fold the left hand-side over just to the crease but not overlapping it. Your folder no has two flaps. We like vin a ruler down each fold to na the fold neater ? rarlatte Do steps 3 and 4 th ret a ining folders.

6. Do steps 5 and 6 to your remaining folders (if any).

7. We provide all of the mini-booklets for your lapbook. Just cut out, fold, and glue them into the folders. Refer to the booklet placement key or the actual mini-booklet page for placement of each mini-booklet.
