



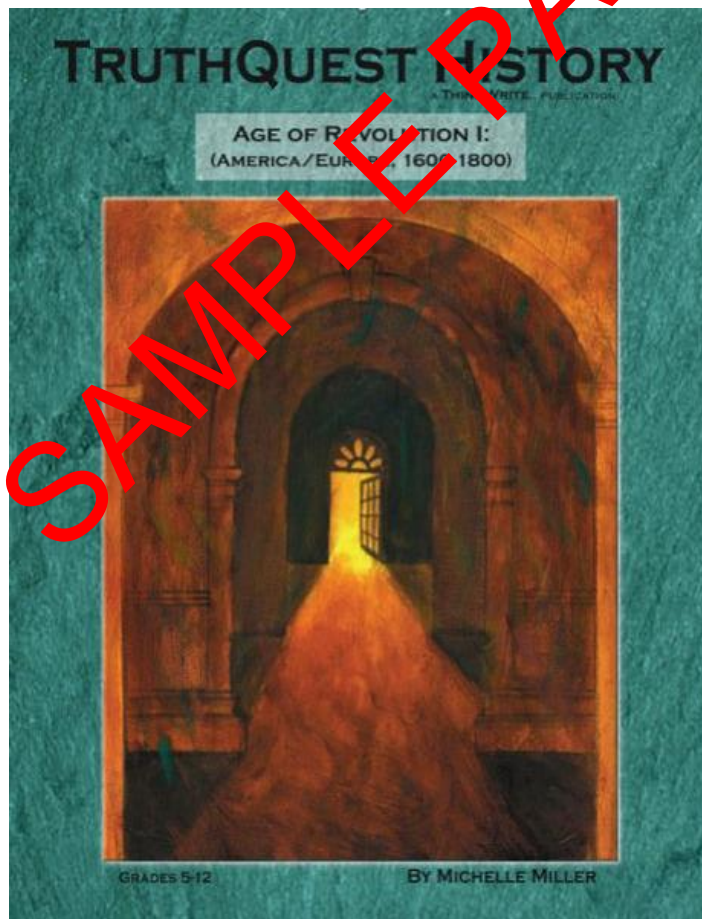

How Do I Use it With TruthQuest History?

TruthQuest History: Age of Revolution I is comprised of 87 units. By also using this companion Binder-Builder, you will be gathering much of what your child is learning and storing it in one fun-packed binder! No more lost papers.

You will still follow TruthQuest History's relaxed and enjoyable learning style. This product is meant to be fun, NOT stressful. Use it to enhance your learning experience. Feel free to tailor the pages to your student. Some days you can simply draw instead of write, for example. The choice is YOURS!

Most of the units have worksheets to aid your child in learning. Please note that not all units will have worksheets. At the beginning of the Binder-Builder, you will find a **Definition Page** and a **Book Log** page. You can make copies of these two pages to use with each unit, if desired. So, gather the kids, and let the learning begin!

How Do I Set Up My Binder-Builder?

Gather all of your pages and 3-hole punch them. Place in 3-ring binder. Add your 19 labeled tabs. (If you are using the Notebooking Package also, you can include those pages.) You will store all of your worksheets behind these tabs.

Located at the top left corner of each page, you will find the unit topic that is to be read in your *TruthQuest History* book. Under that, you will see which tab your sheet is to be filed. Each page will also have all directions for the worksheet.

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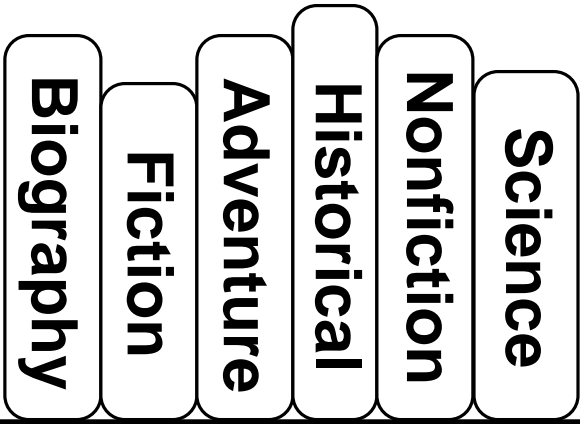

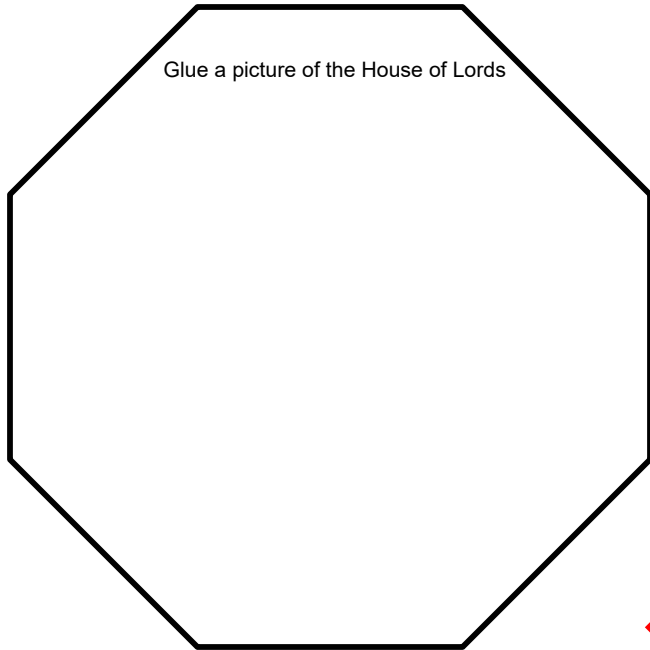

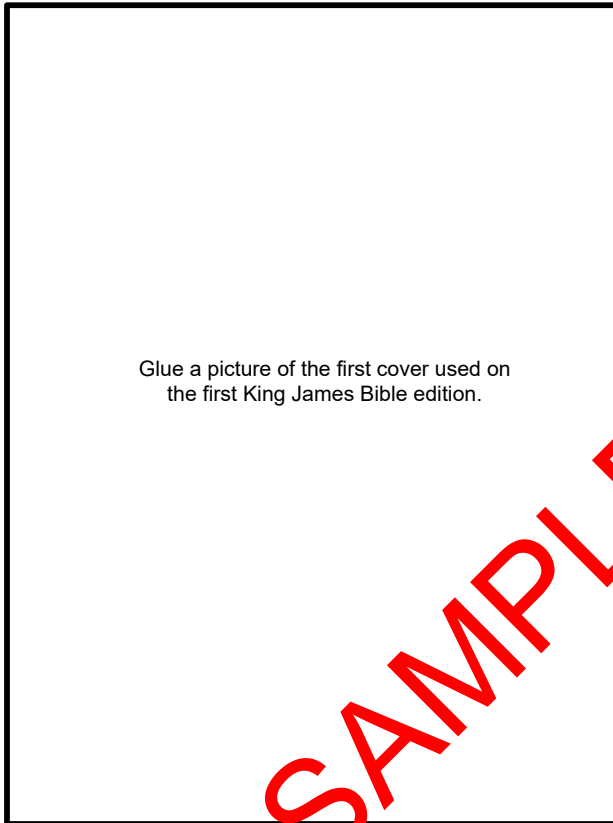
