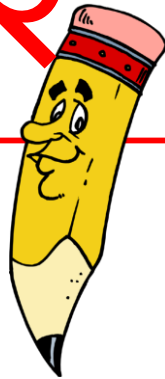

What is Copywork?

Children learn best by following good models. With copywork, your child will copy prewritten models that demonstrate proper grammar, punctuation, spelling, capitalization, spacing, etc. It is to be done in their own handwriting. This not only increases penmanship ability but also gives practice in all the essential language arts skills that are so important in the earlier grades. Some of the world's greatest writers honed their skills through copywork.

Zechariah was the father of John the Baptist and the husband of Elizabeth. He was a Jewish Priest and Pharisee of the line of Abijah during the reign of King Herod.
