What will my child learn?



Use these pages daily!


- Using a **fine tip dry erase pen**, your student can practice the pages in this book multiple times during the week b fore using a pencil to make it permanent.

- Repeat this memory daily during the week until you feel your student knows the information. At that point, your student will fill in the pages using a pencil so that it is permanent






Dress for the time period being studied


