

Hotdog Fold-Fold vertically




Dotted Lines-These are the cutting lines.

Accordion Fold-This fold is like making a paper fan. Fold on the first line so that title is on top. Turn over and fold on next line so that title is on top again. Turn over again and fold again on the next line so that title is on top. Continue until all folds are done.


Cover Labels-Most of the booklets that are folded look nicer with a label on top instead of just a blank space. They will be referred to as "cover label."

How do I know where to place each template in the roder




This placement key tells you the template goes in he first folder at the top of the left flap.




What is a Farmers' Market

Have you ever heard of a farmers' market? You can find farmers' markets year-round. They are a GREAT place to learn about the produce that is grown in your area of the country.

A farmers' market is a physical retail market featuring goods sold directly by farmers to consumers, or people who purchase goods and services for personal use. The farmer is considered a producer. Producers are those who make, grow, or supply goods or commodities to sell. When farmers sell at a farmers' market, they take it straight from their farm to the market. This allows consumers like you get fresh produce. Many consumers also like knowing where the food that they are eating comes from. Farmers can sell at a good price and still make a profit because they do not have to pay a distributor (middle man) to distribute and she their goods to other places.

Farmers' markets are typically lined with booths, tables, and standarded with a wide variety of delicious products for you to purchase. Farmers' markets can be independent or outelors depending upon where the market is located, the kind of products for sea, and ne time of year.


Many farmers' markets also sell things other than product is common to find household items not typically found in stores such as organic soaps and shappoos, natural cleaners, and soy candles. You may also find tasty homemade cakes, cookies, lies, and candy.

History of the Farmers' Market

In America, informal markets have been around since the early settlers in Jamestown. Early American farmers used horse-drawn or riages to haul produce to sell in the center of town. Over the years, this tradition was lost as a merica became an industrialized society. However, in the late 1960s, the idea of local bod began a spark interest again as people began to think more about personal health, the springer and support for family farms.

Today's Farmers' Wark






