How to play

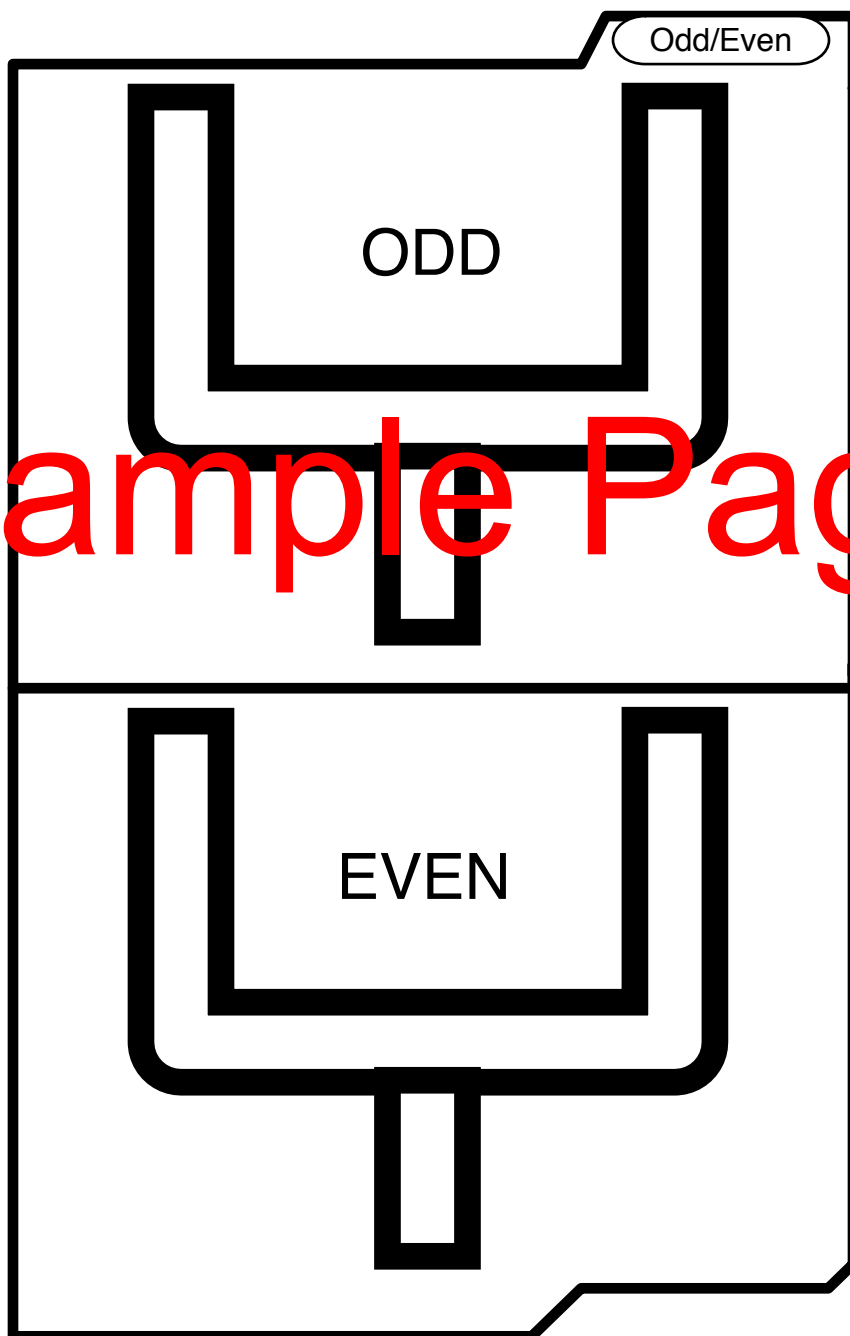
Place the numbers in the odd and even goals. If the number on the football is odd, place it in the odd goal. If the number on the football is even, place it in the even goal.


Also, child can place the footballs in numerical order across the floor or table.

How To Set Up The File Folder

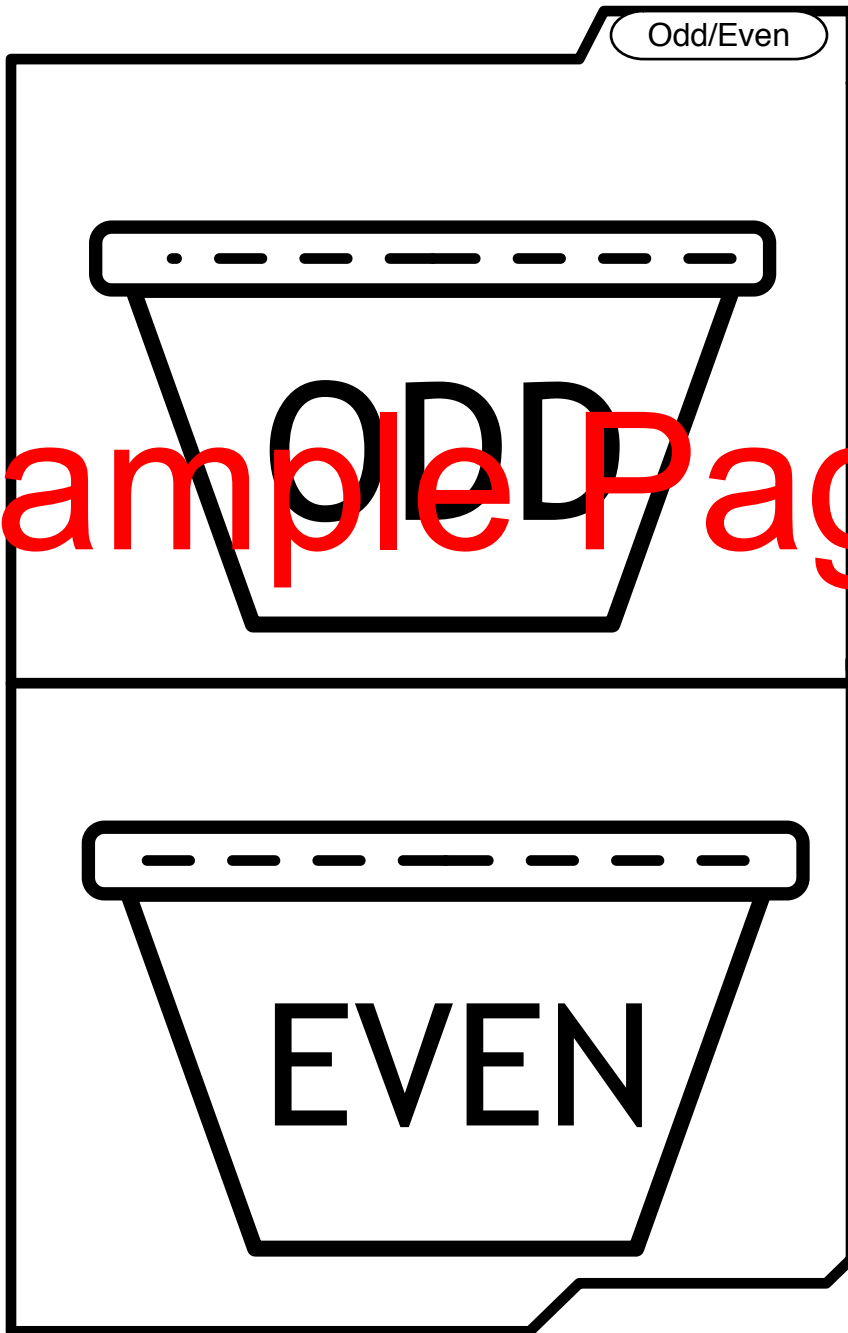
You will need the following: Scissors, glue, 20 craft sticks and one file folder.

On the next two pages you will find your odd/even templates.

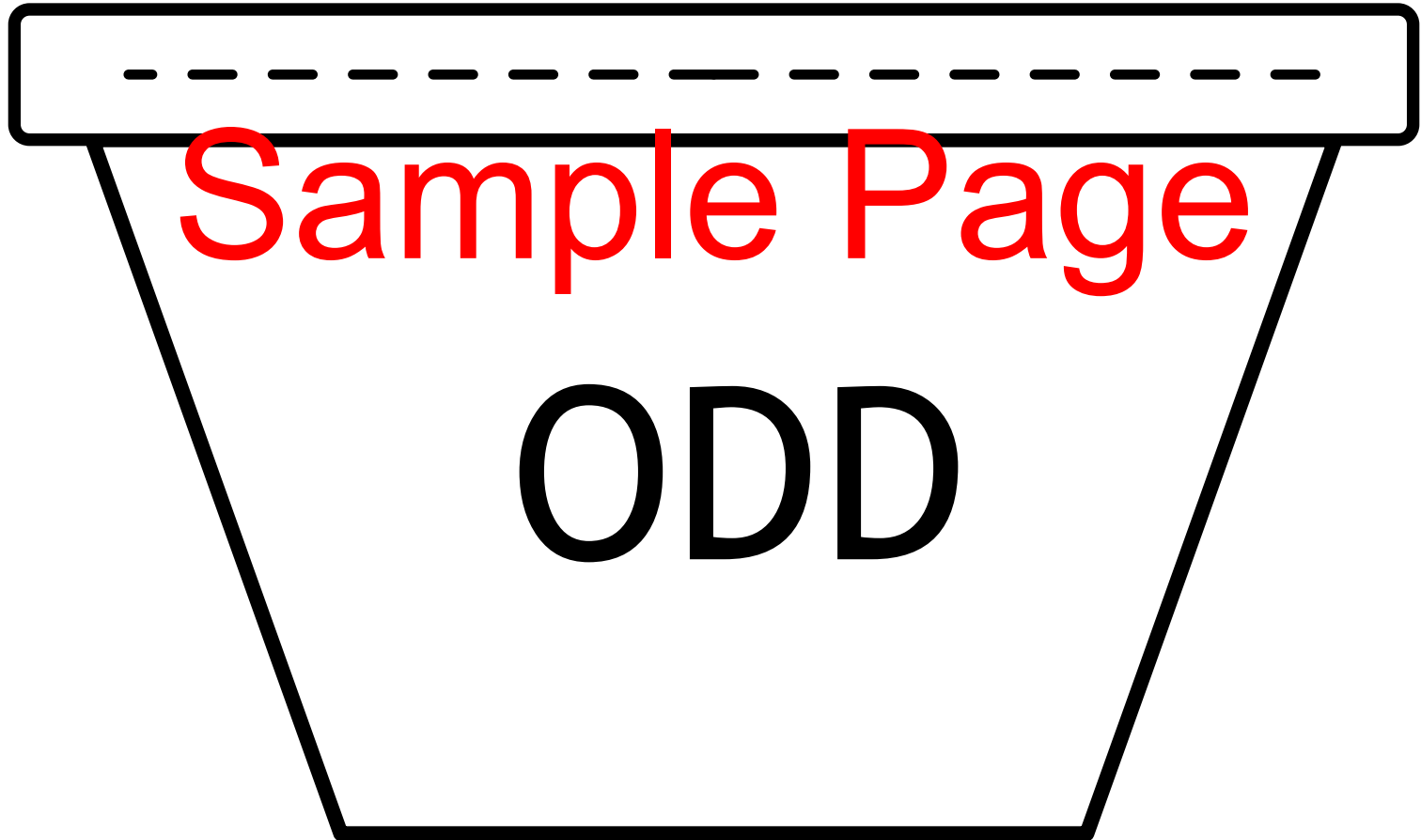
DO NOT CUT OUT THE FLOWER POT.

Glue the entire sheet to the folder.

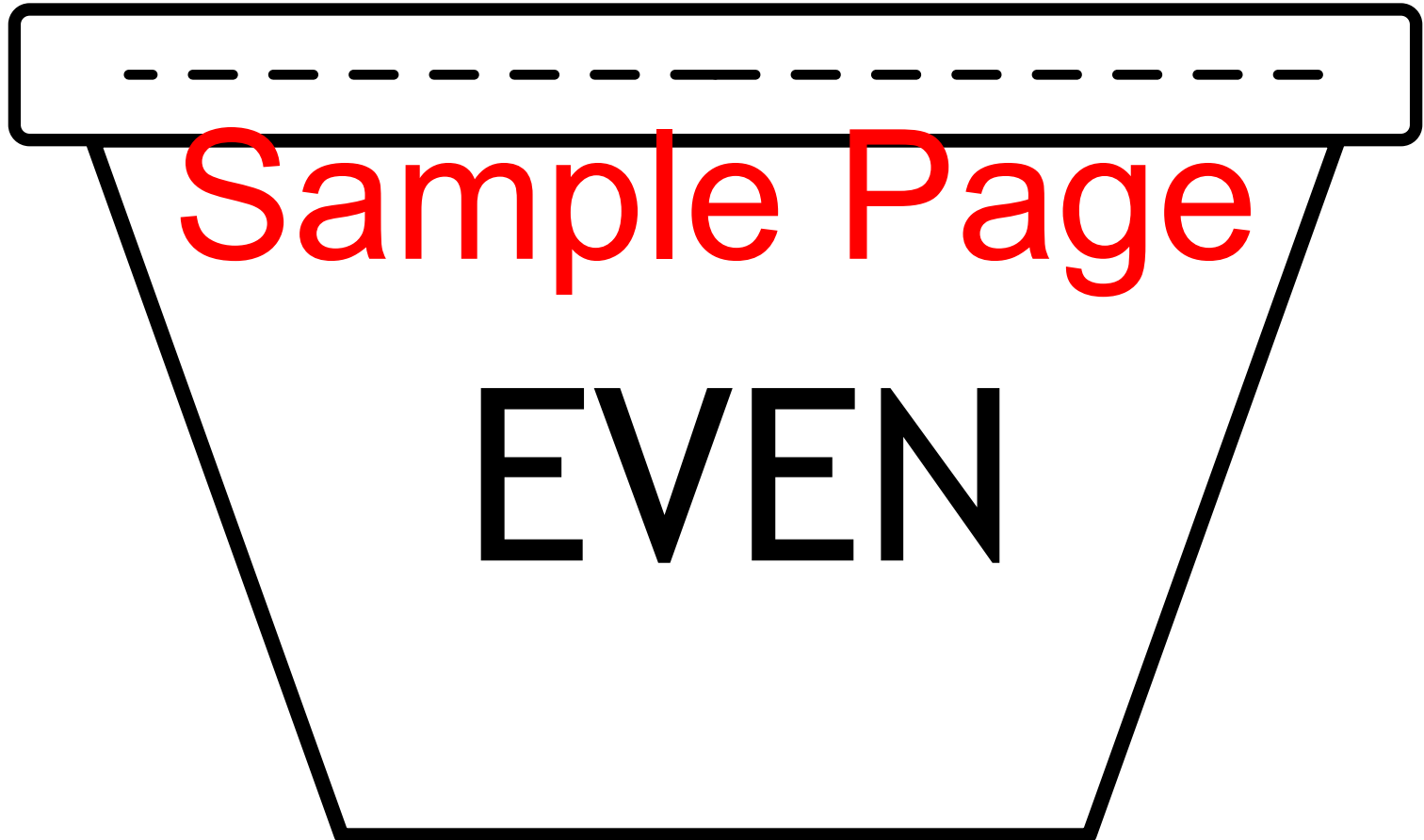

How to play

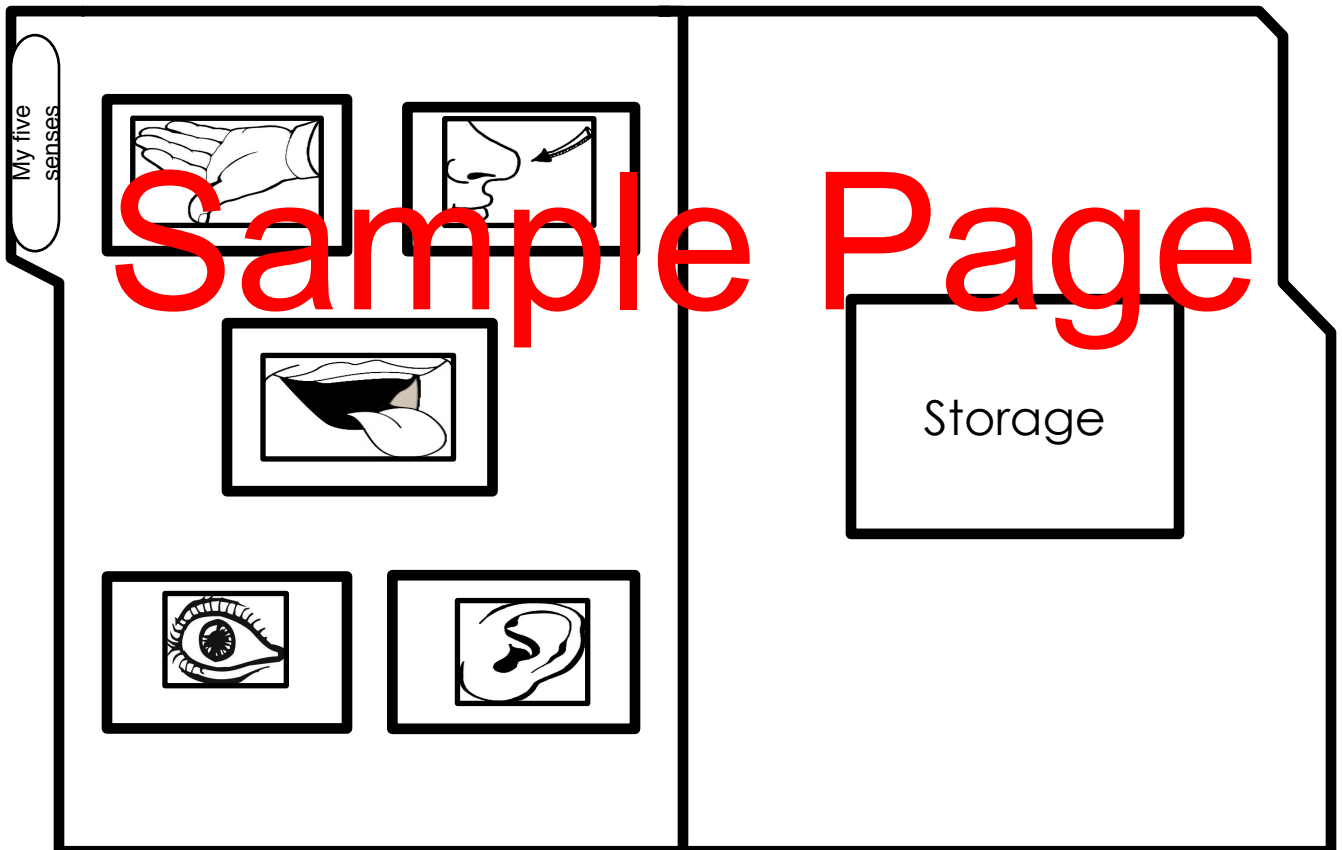

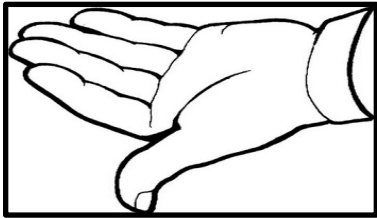
How To Set Up The File Folder

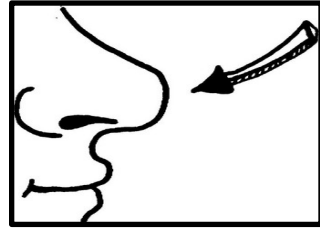
To make your file folder game last longer, you can laminate the cards.



Cut out booklet as one piece. Fold the back bottom section up in back, and then fold the flaps back and glue to make a pocket. Glue onto folder.

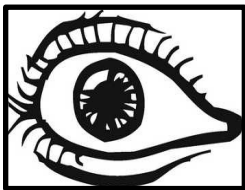
