

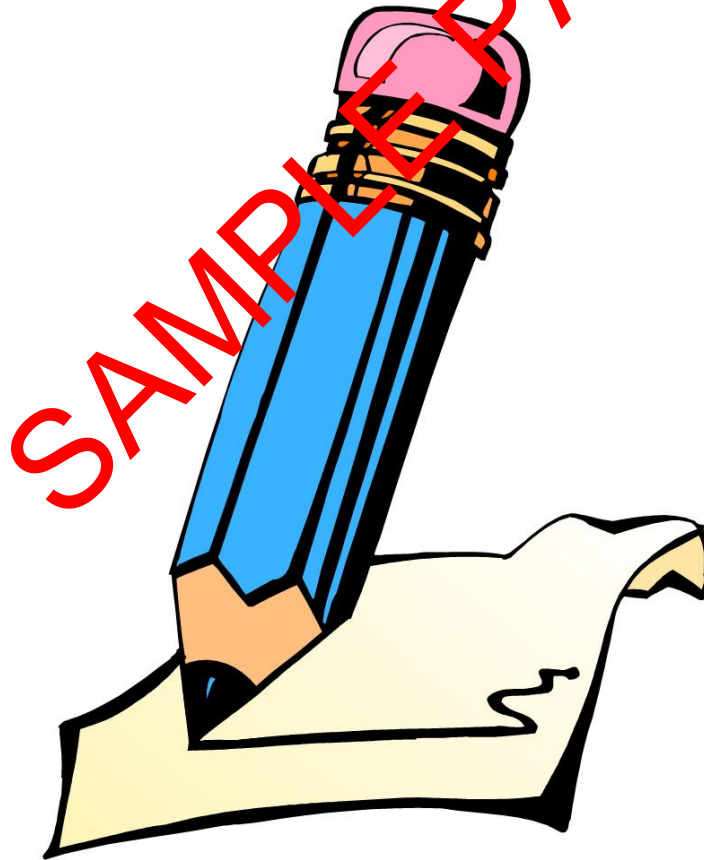

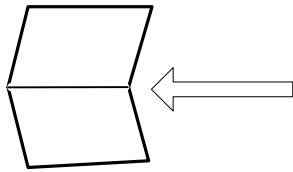

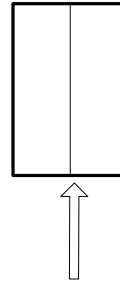

Things to Know

Hamburger Fold-Fold horizontally



Hotdog Fold-Fold vertically



Dotted Lines-These are the cutting lines

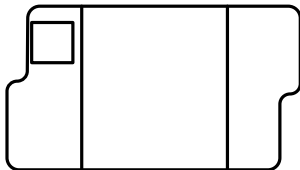
Accordion Fold-This fold is like making a paper fan. Fold on the first line so that title is on top. Turn over and fold on next line so that title is on top again. Turn over again and fold again on the next line so that title is on top. Continue until all folds are done.

Cover Labels-Most of the booklets that are folded look nicer with a label on top instead of just a blank space. They will be referred to as “cover label.”

How do I know where to place each booklet in the lapbook?



Folder 1



This placement key tells you the booklet goes in the first folder at the top of the left flap.

A booklet placement key is at the top of every booklet page. This key shows where that particular booklet will go in that folder.

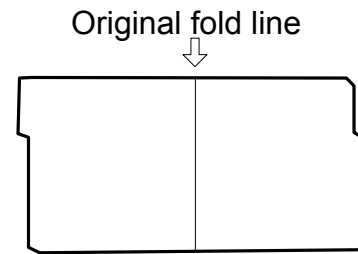
How Do I Use it With Classical Conversations?

The Classical Conversations is broken up into 24 weeks. By using the lapbook along with this wonderful program, you will be able to bring and gather so much of what your child is learning and store it into one fun-packed location.

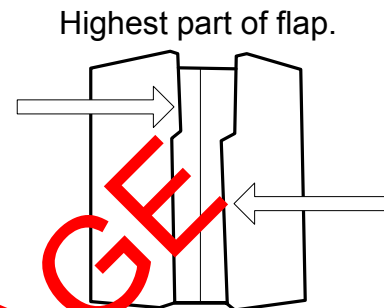
This product is meant to be fun, NOT stressful. So use it to enhance your learning experience. Feel free to tailor the booklets to your child. Some days you can simply draw instead of write. Or find the information on the internet and glue it onto the booklet. The choice is YOURS!

Folding a Lapbook Base

Gather the number of folders required for the project. Fold them flat as seen here.



For each folder, fold the left and right sides inward toward the original line to create two flaps. Crease so that the highest part of each flap is touching the original line. It is important not to let the two flaps overlap. *You may want to take a ruler and run it down each crease to make it sharper.*



Glue your folders together by putting glue (or you may staple) on the inside of the flaps. Then press the newly glued flaps together with your hands until they get a good strong hold to each other. Follow this step to add as many folders as you need for your project. Most of our lapbooks have either 2 or 3 folders.

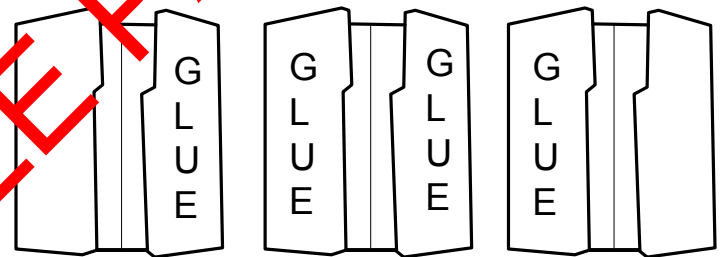
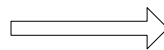


Photo of a completed lapbook base

Glue Stick

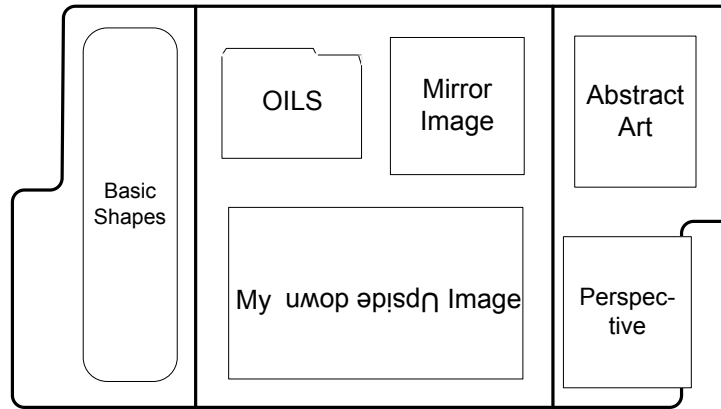
Ruler

Brads—Many booklets use brads to allow you to fan out the booklets. This allows a great way to see all of the booklets for reviewing.

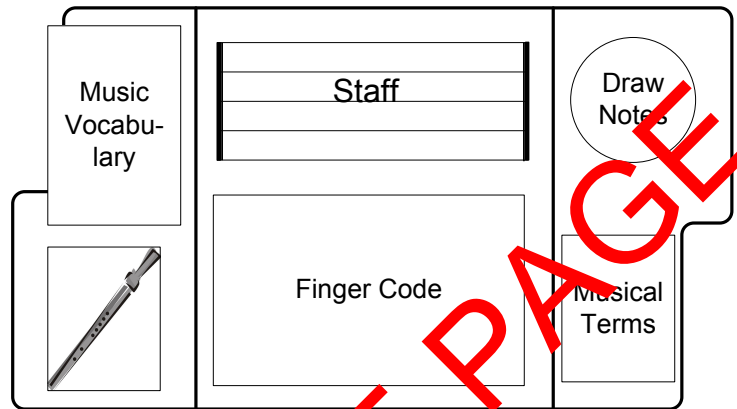
Stapler

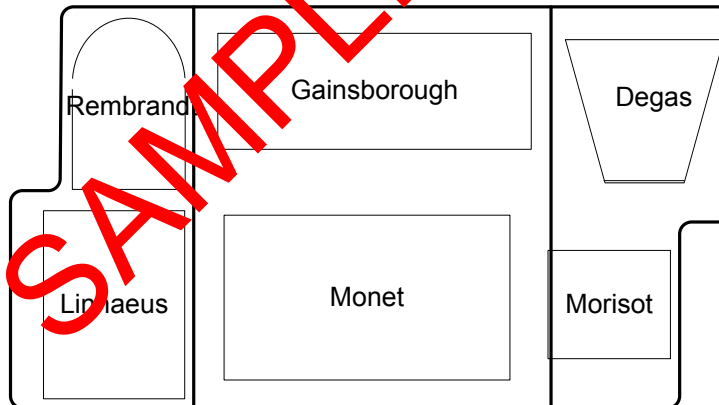

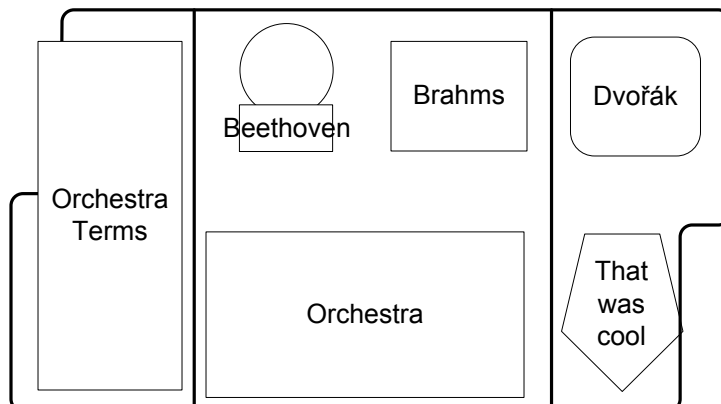

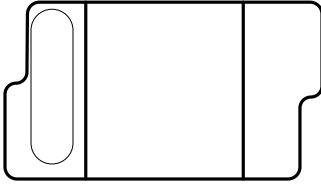


Cut out and glue onto the front of your closed lapbook. Chose one of the artists that you will study this year. Copy one of their pieces on the front cover.

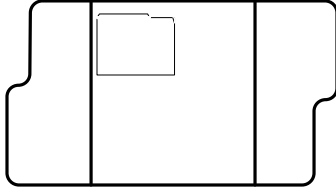

Work on memorizing this week's Fine Arts.

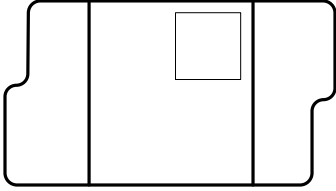
Cut out the booklet as one piece. Fold in half. Glue into lapbook.
