



What you need to get started



Cover Labels- Some of the booklets will have a cover label that will need to be glued to the top to cover a blank space.

What is a Binder-Builder?

A Binder-Builder is a new name for an old concept! It is simply taking a 3-ring binder and colored cardstock and turning it into a wonderful showcase of your child's learning year!

How Do I Use it With A Story of Us?

The Story of Us book is broken up into 36 units. Each page in the Binder-Builder will cover three chapters. By using the Binder-Builders along with this wonderful book, you will be able to bring and gather so much of what your child is learning and store it into one fun-packed binder! No more lost papers.


As you read through The Story of Us, use the Binder-Builder to re-tell what your child has learned. Feel free to tailor the booklets to your child. Some days you can simply draw instead of write. Or find the information on the internet and glue it onto the booklet. The choice is YOURS!


How Do I Set Up My Binder-Builder?

Gather your pieces of cardstock and 3-hole punch them. Next, in the lower righthand corner number you cardstock from 1-13. Place in 3-ring binder. The front of the first page will have your cover sheet glued to it. Then, your **first** "detail" sheet will be glued to the **back** of that page. The **booklets** for your **first** chapter will then be glued to the **front** of your **second** page. This lay-out allows you to view anything for the chapter you are studying at the same time! You will follow this process throughout the entire binder-builder.

Located at the top right corner of each page, you will find the chapter and the pages where it can be found in The Story of Us book. Each page will also have all directions for the construction of the mini-booklet, pages to read, and what your student will record in the mini-booklet after reading to show what is learned. A small key is also here to show you where to glue each mini-booklet onto the card stock. Front of Binder- Page slides down into front sleeve insert. Not all binders have a front


sleeve insert so this sheet is optional.






Left side- Chapters 4-6 Vocabulary Right Side- Chapters 4-6 Booklets

Cover Sheet. Cut out the cover sheet and glue to the first page of your Binder-Builder. On the lines, write your answer to the question.




Read Chapter 1.


Cut out the booklet. Glue onto the front of page 2. **Directions:** Draw the silhouette of George Washington on the easel.



Read Chapter 2.

Cut out as one booklet. Fold down flap and then fold over the other so that title is on top. Cut out the labels and glue onto blank sides of booklet. Glue onto the front of page 2. **Directions:** Under each tab, write what you have learned.






Read Chapter 3.

Cut out the booklet as one piece. Hamburger fold in half so that words are on top. Cut on the dotted lines to form three flaps. Glue onto the front of page 2.


Directions: Under each flap, tell about each party.


Read Chapter 4.

Read Chapter 5.

Cut out the booklet as one piece. Fold in half. Cut out cover label. Glue to the front of the closed booklet. Glue onto the front of page 3. **Directions:** Fill out your own census.



(Read Chapter 6.

Cut out the booklet as one piece. Fold in half. Glue onto the front of page 3.
