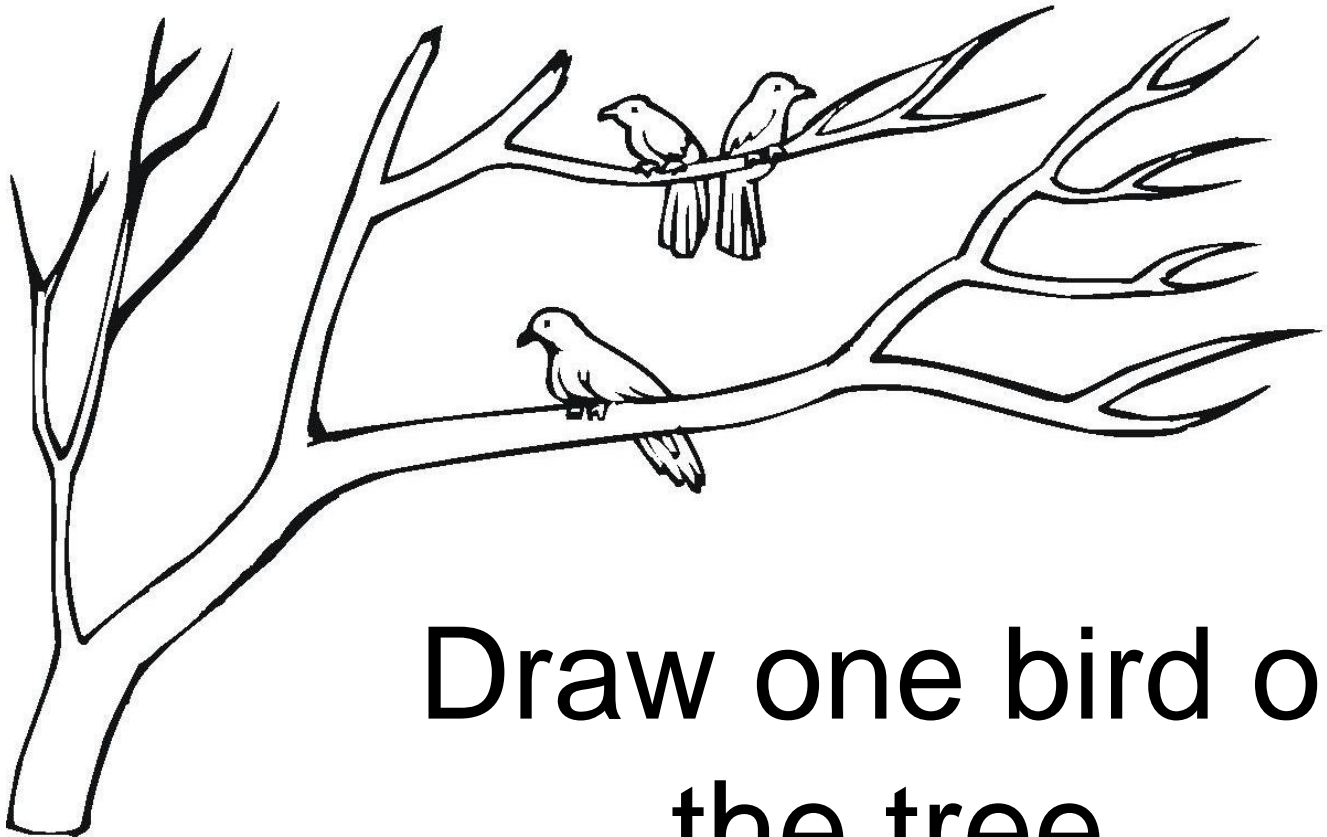

To begin-This is not a lapbook. It's just a cute series of number practice pages that we've created.

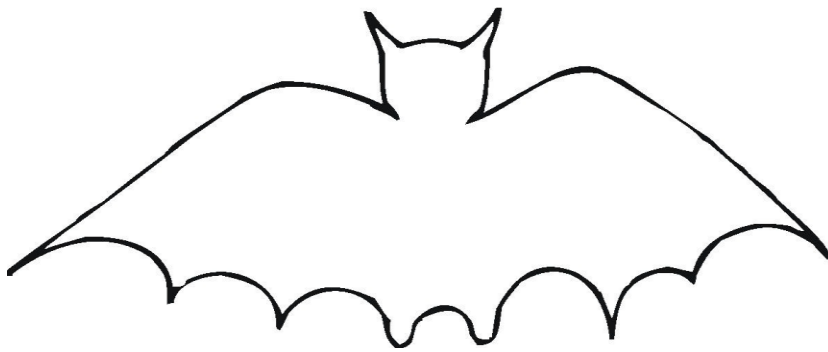
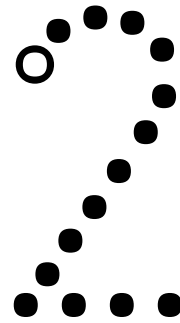
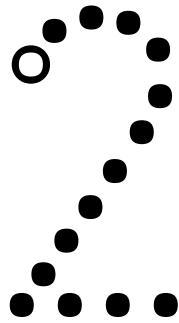
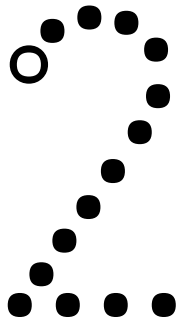

If you would like to use the pages over and over, laminate each page or place inside of page protectors.

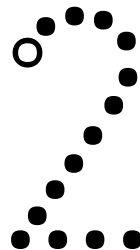
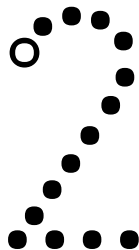
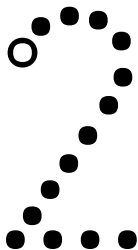


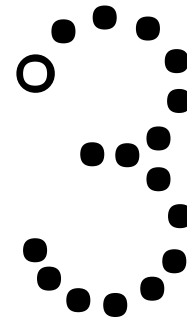
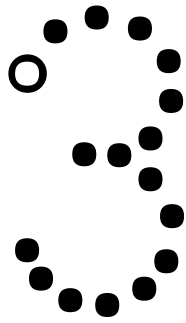
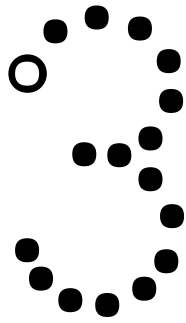
