The first person to call Native Americans "Indians" was Christopher Columbus. He thought he had landed on one of the islands east of India called the Indies.

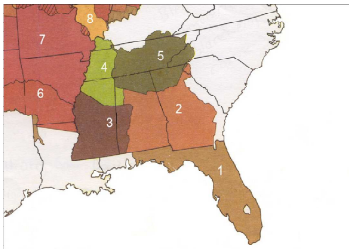
