### Folder 1



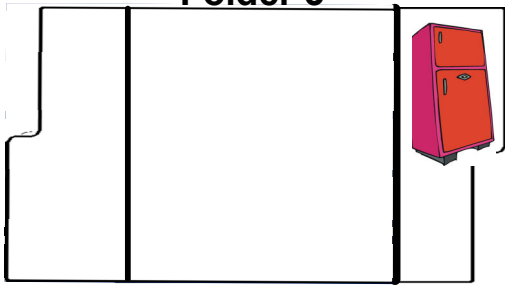

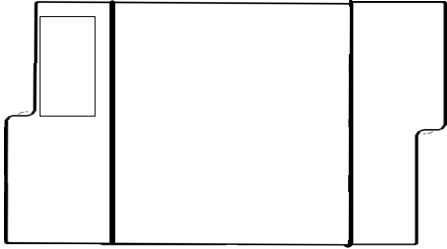
### Folder 3

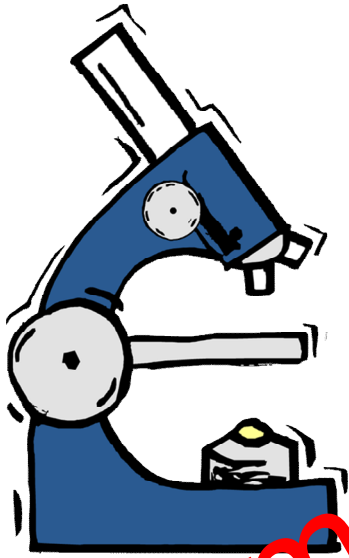


Folder 3
