


Folding a Lapbook Base

Original fold line


Gather the number of folders required for the project. Fold them flat as seen here. Highest part of flap. For each folder, fold the left and right sides inward toward the original line to create two flaps. Crease so that the highest part of each flap is touching the original line. It is important not to let the two flaps overlap. You may want to take a ruler and run it down each crease to make it sharper. Glue your folders together by putting give (or you may staple) on the inside of the hops. Then G G G G press the newly glued flaps together with your L L L L hands until they get a good strong hold to each U U other.
