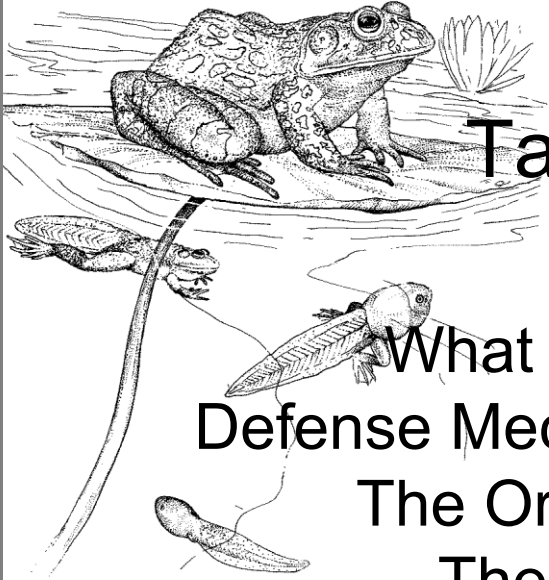

## What is Notebooking?

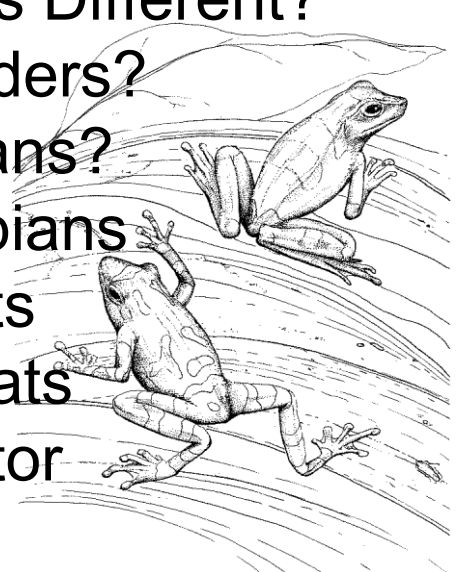

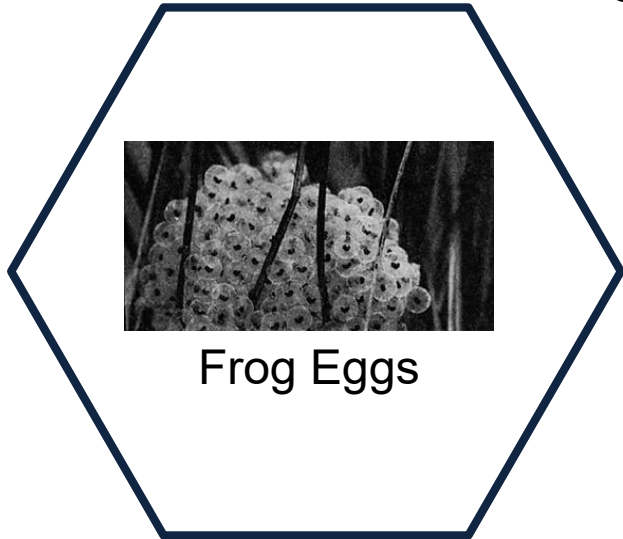
