LED TROFFER RETROFIT FIXTURES

INSTALL INSTRUCTIONS

PLEASE FIND A QUALIFIED ELECTRICIAN FOR INSTALLATION. Please read the instructions before you install and use the luminaire.

Before installing, servicing, or performing routine maintenance upon this equipment, follow these general precautions:

- WARNING Risk of Fire or Electric Shock. The electrical rating of these
 products are 120-277V, the installer must determine whether they have
 120-277V at the luminaire before installation.
- WARNING Risk of Fire or Electric Shock. LED Retrofit Kit installation requires knowledge of luminaires electrical systems. If not qualified, do not attempt installation. Contact a qualified electrician.
- WARNING Risk of Fire or Electric Shock. Install this kit only in luminaires
 that have the construction features and dimensions shown in the
 photographs and/or drawings; and where the input rating of the retrofit
 kit does not exceed the input rating of the luminaire.
- WARNING To prevent wiring damage or abrasion, do not expose wiring to edges of sheet metal or other sharp objects.
- WARNING Risk of Fire or Electric Shock. Luminaire wiring and electrical parts may be damaged when drilling for installation of LED Retrofit Kit. Check for enclosed wiring and components.
- Do not make or alter any open holes in an enclosure of wiring or electrical components during kit installation.
- Turn off electrical power at fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring fixture to the power supply.
- Turn off the power when you perform any maintenance.

- All wiring connections should be capped with UL approved wire connectors.
- To reduce the risk of death, personal injury or property damage from fire, electric shock, falling parts, cuts/abrasions, and other hazards read all warnings and instructions included with and on the fixture box and all fixture labels.
- Commercial installation, service and maintenance of luminaires should be performed by a qualified licensed electrician.
- For the installation: If you are unsure about the installation or maintenance of the luminaires, consult a qualified licensed electrician and check your local electrical code.


- Avoid direct eye exposure to the un-louvered light source while it is on.
- Account for small parts and destroy packing material, as these may be hazardous to children.
- Risk of burn. Disconnect power and allow fixture to cool before changing bulb or handling fixture.
- Green ground screw provided in proper location. DO NOT RELOCATE.
- Minimum 90° supply connectors.
- Suitable for Dry or Damp location, Type IC





INSTALLATION

- Prior to installation, disconnect all incoming power to fixture. Remove existing hardware (lens/lens frame, parabolic louver, reflectors/ballast covers, brackets, lamps/lamp holders). Leave supply and grounding leads. (Fig. 1)
 - **NOTE:** Follow all federal and local regulations when disposing of lamps and removed components.
- Install LED panel end brackets to each end of the existing fixture by gently lifting it and placing LED panel end brackets between the fixture and T-grid.
- If there is a gap between the fixture and T-grid, LED panel side brackets can be installed between the fixture and T-grid. There are two tabs to allow for placing the side brackets into the slot of end brackets. (Fig. 2)
- 4. Secure the LED panel brackets to the existing fixture using the provided #8 x 1/2" self-drilling screws. (Fig.3)
- 5. Locate the LED Troffer Retrofit onto the keyholes of the end brackets, and then slide the LED Troffer Retrofit horizontally onto the end slots. (Fig. 4)

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



- 6. Hook the safety cables into the holes positioned on the end brackets.
- 7. Use the provided wire caps to connect the wire leads of the troffer kit to the main power leads. (Black-Live, White-Neutral and Green-Ground) (Fig. 5)
- 8. Secure the LED Troffer Retrofit by locking the latches riveted on each end of the frame. (Fig.6)

*Per NEMA rule-change, gray-color dimming control wires will be changing to pink as new productions come in.



$\textbf{SPEC-SELECT}^{\text{\tiny{TM}}} \ \textbf{FIXTURES - FIELD ADJUSTABLE WATTAGE \& CCT} \\ (\textit{If applicable})$

The end users may adjust the color temperature and lumen output, respectively, by the two slide switches integrated into the back of the fixture. Each switch has 3 options (left, middle and right), each position corresponds to 1 of 3 color temperatures (3500K, 4100K, and 5000K) and 1 of 3 wattages, which can be adjusted to the desired combination.

- 1. Switches are located on the driver. (Fig. 7)
- 2. Select a wattage and color temperature by sliding switch left or right respectively to the desired value. (Fig. 7)
