

Dear Valued Customer: January 21,2020

Prop 65 requires businesses to provide warnings on/with their products to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. By law, a warning must be given for Prop 65 listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause bith defects or other reproductive harm. If a warning label is placed on/with a products, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.*

Suncos's products can contain Prop 65 chemicals, but simply because a component is subject to Prop 65 does not mean a warning on/with the finished printed product is required. Sunco's products typically contain Pop 65 chemicals that are volatile in nature yet do not pose and exposure risk when on finished, printed articles. One cured or dried on a finished article, it is highly unlikely that exposures would occur.

Further to this, warning requirements are dependent on the anticipated level of exposure to the Prop 65 chemicals, which result from the foreseeable uses of a product. The warning requirements will only apply if the foreeable and intended uses of a product containing these chemicals are likely to result in exposures that exceed the "significant risk" or "observable effect" levels. A determination of "significant risk" or "observable effect" can only be made with full knowledge of the end uses and applications of the products.

Sunco does not control or have knowledge of the end uses of our products. Sunco, therefore, cannot make any guarantee regarding the actual exposure levels to the Prop 65 chemicals. Sunco recommends customers review the Prop 65 regulation to determine their appropiate methods and requirements for compliance concerning Prop 65. The decision to include or not to include a Prop 65 notice (label) must ultimately rest with the company using Sunco products.
