PLEASE FIND A QUALIFIED ELECTRICIAN FOR INSTALLATION. Please read the instructions before you install and use the linear tube(s).

GENERAL: ALL ELECTRICAL CONNECTIONS MUST BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH LOCAL AND NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE (N.E.C.) STANDARDS. IF YOU ARE UNFAMILIAR WITH PROPER ELECTRICAL WIRING CONNECTIONS OBTAIN THE SERVICES OF A QUALIFIED ELECTRICIAN. REMOVE THE TRIM FROM THE BOX AND MAKE SURE THAT NO PARTS ARE MISSING.


UL TYPE B - Direct Wire (Ballast Bypass) directly connects to the main: 120-277V • 50/60Hz, single or double ended.








- 4. Place LED lamp in luminaire and insert lamp pins into luminaire lampholders.
- 5. Rotate LED lamp until lamp locks in place. Ensure that the LED lamp front points away from the back of the luminaire.
- 6. Note: Install one LED T8 replacement lamp for each fluorescent lamp removed.
- 7. Place lens or diffuser back in place (if applicable).
- 8. Power On.

UL TYPE B - DIRECT WIRE (Ballast Bypass) DOUBLE ENDED INSTALLATION


TYPE B LAMP – intended for operation in luminaires with traditional fluorescent-type lampholders wired directly to the branch circuit. This includes both factory-wired luminaries as well as those converted for this purpose under a retrofit program. Read all WARNINGS before continuing this section.

This item is rated at 120-277VAC. Installer must determine whether line voltage 120-277V is available at the luminaire before installation. Make sure POWER IS TURNED OFF AT THE SOURCE. Do not simply switch off fixture.

- 1. Remove existing covers from the light fixtures according to the light fixture manufacturer's instructions. Carefully remove the existing fluorescent tubes and dispose of them according to federal, state and local laws.
- 2. Cut off wires connected to ballast, and remove ballast (and starter if present). Dispose of removed ballast according to federal, state and local laws.
- 3. Connect Line (L) from power source into lamp holder. This will be "Line In".
- 4. Connect Neutral (N) from power source into opposite end lamp holder. This will be "Neutral In".
- 5. If installing a single tube refer to typical wiring diagrams on the following page. If connecting multiple lamps, continue reading.
- 6. Connect separate Line wire into "Line out" from primary source lamp holder and connect that wire into "Line in" on the adjacent tube.
- 7. Connect separate neutral wire into "Neutral out" from primary source lamp holder and connect that wire into "Neutral in" on the adjacent tube. Refer to typical wiring diagrams on the following page.
- 8. This fixture is now powered as double-ended, for use with bypass tubes where opposite ends are marked with L and N, respectively.
- 9. Install double-ended bypass lamp into the wired lamp holders.
- 10. Visibly affix "Modification Sticker" and reinstall housing cover and lens if applicable. CAUTION: "This luminaire has been modified to operate LED lamps. Do not attempt to install or operate fluorescent lamps in this luminaire," shall be marked on the retrofit luminaire where readily visible by the user during normal maintenance including re-lamping.
- 11. Return power back to source and installation is now completed.

If dimming is required (Type B), only operate with specific dimmer manufactured by Lutron; NTELV-300, CTELV-303P, DVELV-303P, or SELV-300P. Dimmers only operates on 120V.

DOUBLE ENDED - The below ballast wiring represents typical configuration. The actual ballast wiring varies according to the ballast model. It is not a requirement to change the sockets (if in good condition) to operate double ended tubes, regardless of the socket type. Please make sure one side of the fixture is connected to Line (L) and the other side to Neutral (N).





UL TYPE B - DIRECT WIRE (Ballast Bypass) DOUBLE ENDED INSTALLATION








RETROFIT LUMINAIRE WITH THREE LAMPS

UL TYPE B - DIRECT WIRE (Ballast Bypass) SINGLE END INSTALLATION



WARNING DISCONNECT POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING.

TYPE B LAMP – intended for operation in luminaires with traditional fluorescent-type lampholders wired directly to the branch circuit. This includes both factory-wired luminaries as well as those converted for this purpose under a retrofit program.

This wiring method requires NON-SHUNTED lampholders. (Fig. 1)

Read all WARNINGS before continuing this section.

This item is rated at 120-277VAC. Installer must determine whether line voltage 120-277V is available at the luminaire before installation. Make sure POWER IS TURNED OFF AT THE SOURCE. Do not simply switch off fixture.

- Remove existing covers from the light fixtures according to the light fixture
 manufacturer's instructions. Carefully remove the existing fluorescent
 tubes and dispose of them according to federal, state and local laws.
- Cut off wires connected to ballast, and remove ballast (and starter if present). Dispose of removed ballast according to federal, state and local laws
- Connect Line (L) from power source into one side of the non-shunted lamp holder. This will be "Line In".
- 4. Connect Neutral (N) from power source into the other side of the non-shunted into lamp holder. This will be "Neutral In".
- 5. If installing a single tube refer to typical wiring diagrams on the following page. If connecting multiple lamps, continue reading.
- 6. Connect separate Line wire into "Line out" from primary source lamp holder and connect that wire into "Line in" on the adjacent tube.
- 7. Connect separate neutral wire into "Neutral out" from primary source lamp holder and connect that wire into "Neutral in" on the adjacent tube. Refer to typical wiring diagrams on the following page.
- 8. This fixture is now powered at one end only, for use with bypass tubes where one end is marked with both L and N, for each pin respectively. (Fig. 2)
- 9. Install lamp with the L and N markings into the wired lamp holder end.
- $10.\ \mbox{Visibly affix "Modification Sticker"}$ and reinstall housing cover and lens if applicable.

CAUTION: "This luminaire has been modified to operate LED lamps. Do not attempt to install or operate fluorescent lamps in this luminaire," shall be marked on the retrofit luminaire where readily visible by the user during normal maintenance including re-lamping.

11. Return power back to source and installation is now completed.

If dimming is required (Type B), only operate with specific dimmer manufactured by Lutron; NTELV-300, CTELV-303P, DVELV-303P, or SELV-300P. Dimmers only operates on 120V.
