# 2020 MEN'S MICHIGAN GRAND SLAM TOURNAMENT SERIES

REMINDER – ALL players must get an individual player sanction number (**FREE**) to be on any NSA roster – This is a one-time player registration and will be a **lifetime number** for all players.

**PLUS Build your team based on individual player point values.**

***ALL Michigan Teams wanting to participate in TOURNAMENT PLAY must sanction online as a Tournament Team. League sanctions will NOT be accepted for Tournament Play.***

**2020 NSA Team Membership (Sanction) fee is \$40 and must be completed online, PAID to National Office.**

### Team Classification Points

Platinum – 102.01 plus

Elite – 74.01 - 102

Gold – 50.01 - 74

Silver – 29.01 - 50

Bronze – 24-29

Player with 4.25 pt. or higher can't play Bronze \* Player with 6.25 pt. or higher can't play Silver \* Player with 8.25 pt. or higher can't play Gold.

2 Guest players per weekend (player(s) will drop off on Monday morning)  
WSQ's ONLY (Grand Slam's) teams will retain Berth/Travel & National Points.  
NOT PERMITTED IN Championship Play (State/NIT/REG/World/Supers)

## EQUALIZER RULE

**Equalizer will be used in combo tournaments:  
Elite/Gold/Silver, Elite/Gold, Gold/Silver, Gold/Silver/Bronze & Silver/Bronze**

**Lower class team will be spotted 3 runs per Upper class they are playing in each individual game.**

## **MEN'S Grand Slam Series Divisions:**

### **Men's Elite, Gold, Silver & Bronze**

The **Grand Slam Tournament Series**, is a series of Tournaments your team can play in.  
Each Tournament is a WORLD SERIES and SUPER REGIONAL QUALIFIER.

### **Men's Grand Slam Entry Fees:**

**Entry Deadlines for Grand Slams: 5:00 PM on WEDNESDAY prior to the tournament date.**

**Discounts offered to teams that pay 1 full week in advance - by FRIDAY, one week prior to the tournament date.**

**Men's Grand Slam – Elite, Gold, Silver & Bronze - \$250**  
**DISCOUNT of \$25 (\$225) if paid one week prior to the tournament entry date.**

**Michigan Adult Teams can PAY for selected tournaments ONLINE by Charge.**

Teams can also pay for their NSA membership/sanction fee ONLINE by charge.

Teams can enter tournaments online and Mail payments, but must meet all deadlines.

Certain tournaments will still require an official NSA Post Season Entry Form and are marked as such.

### **2020 UMPIRE FEES:**

**Tournaments with Elite or Gold Teams will pay \$15 per game per team at field at game time**

**Gold/Silver Tournaments- Teams will pay \$15 per game per team at field at game time**

**SILVER, BRONZE, Women's and COED – Teams will pay \$13 per game per team at field at game time**

### **Hit your own Ball!**

**Teams supply NSA Approved Optic Yellow Black Stitch**

**ALL NSA will use the 44/400 or 52/275**

**Defensive team and/or Umpire must be able to identify the Manufacturers core rating or the ball can be removed from play. Offensive Team: Puts ball in play at the beginning of EACH Inning. Offensive Team:**

**Replaces the ball each time the ball is hit out of play.**

**Balls will be sold at each site or see "Softball Prices" for team pricing.**

## **2020 Men's "OVERALL" GRAND SLAM 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> Travel Money**

Based on teams participating in Grand Slam, NIT, State & Super State a % listed below will be given in each division. Men's Elite, Gold, Silver and Bronze.

**1<sup>st</sup> Place: 50% of each classification totals**

**2<sup>nd</sup> Place: 35% of each classification totals**

**3<sup>rd</sup> Place: 15% of each classification totals**

**Teams must participate in a minimum of 8 NSA Tournaments to be eligible for overall Grand Slam Awards, tournament includes (Grand Slam, NIT, East/West States, Super States, Super Regional and World).**

# 2020 STATE BONUS POINTS

*Bonus points are State Bonus points and only good for seeding in East/West States, Super State Championships and for overall Grand Slam Awards.*

ALL East/West State & Super State Championships will be seeded by the National Points PLUS the State Bonus points by the deadline date for the Individual State & Super State Championships.

**Park Policy:** Every NSA Complex has their own Park rules and these rules will have to be abided by or offenders of the rules will be eliminated from the tournament and could also receive a one (1) year suspension from NSA play.

**ALL TEAMS MUST PARTICIPATE IN EITHER EAST or WEST STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS to validate berths and to qualify for the SUPER STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.**

ALL Teams must participate in a State to Validate Super Regional or World Series Berth

ALL Teams must participate in an East/West State, PLUS either Super Regional or World Series to Validate a Super World Series Berth

ALL Teams earning a Participation Berth to the Super Worlds must Validate by participating in East/West State, PLUS either Super Regional or World Series.

All Bats must be on the Approved Equipment - Bat List for NSA sanctioned events - Available online 24/7 at [www.PlayNSA.com](http://www.PlayNSA.com) click on: Approved Equipment Select: Approved BAT LIST.

All teams MUST complete a NSA roster on the NSA ONLINE SYSTEM. It must be complete with all information correct. Teams must bring a signed copy to turn in for each tournament.

Roster checks may be done anytime during the tournament. PLAYERS MUST SHOW DRIVERS LICENSE or GOVERNMENT ISSUED PICTURE ID. Players are required to have photo ID at all times.
