How to use your LOOKEE® Pulse Oximeter -- Quick Guide and Tips

Clinical Restrictions:

As the measure is taken on the basis of arteriole pulse, substantial pulsating blood flow of subject is required. For a subject with weak pulse due to shock, low ambient/body temperature, major bleeding, or use of vascular contracting drug, the SpO2 waveform (PLETH) will decrease. In this case, the measurement will be more sensitive to interference.



Quick Operation Guide:

- 1. Please install the 2 x AAA batteries inside the product with the correct directions.
 - 2.Press the bottom to open the probe






- 3. Insert the finger into the bottom of the monitor. To get the best results, make sure the center of the fingerprint is aligned with the emission sensor with red LED.
- 4. Press the button to turn it on. Wait for a couple of seconds to get the readings.

The Most Common Problem: Can't get accurate readings or the reading is jumping around and not stable.

Solutions:

- A. Please make sure your finger is warm.
- B. Please make sure the finger doesn't have a long nail and the fingertip can reach the end of finger chamber.
- C. Adjust your finger position to make sure the center of the fingerprint is aligned with the emission sensor with red LED.
- D. Please rest your hand on a table or flat surface to avoid moving.
