



# FIRE CLAY FACTS AND CARE



Fire clay is known for its strength and durability. It is a specific type of clay that is fired at around 1600 degrees to create a stone-like material. Its non-porous surface makes it highly resistant to heat, chipping, cracking and discoloring, as well as acid and most other solutions. Its stability during firing allows it to maintain a flat, waveless surface when used for large pieces. This has made it very popular in both the kitchen and bathroom.

## Care and Maintenance

Fire clay is very easy to maintain. Simply clean with a soft cloth or sponge using a mild soap and warm water. Be sure to rinse thoroughly and wipe dry. A general purpose cleaner can be used for more heavy duty cleaning. To remove surface scratches use a blue (non-abrasive) scotch brite pad with Soft Scrub Cleanser with Bleach.
