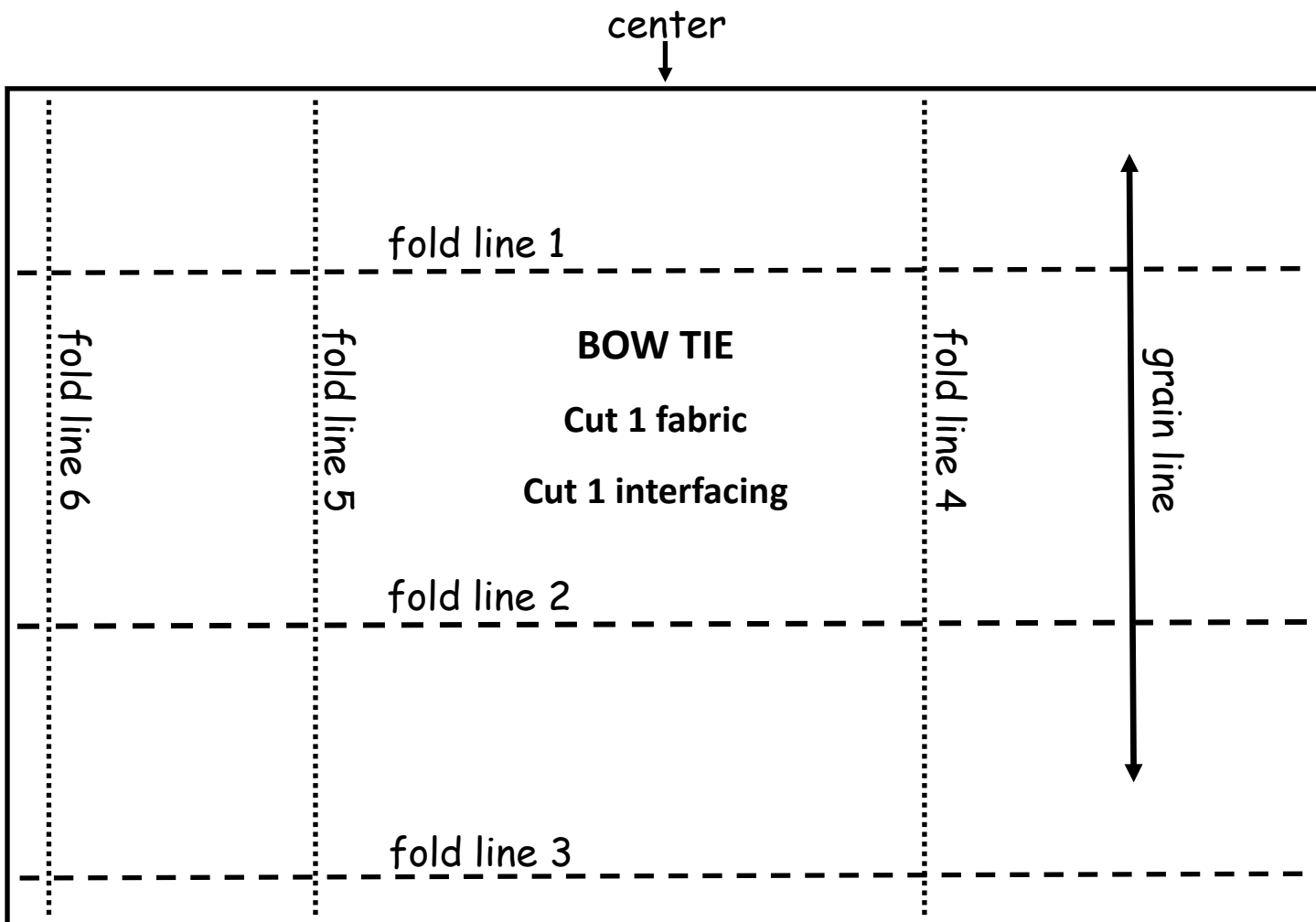

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# Bow Tie Pattern

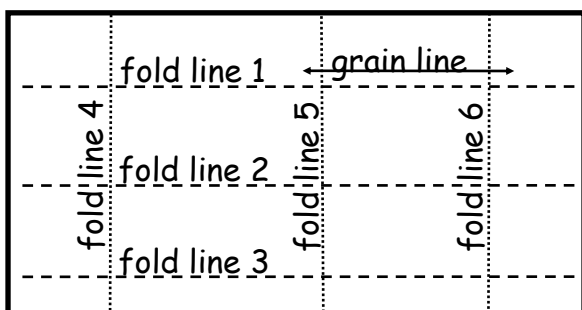
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## BOW TIE CENTER KNOT

Cut 1 fabric

Cut 1 interfacing



### Supplies

- Man's necktie or 1/4 yard fabric
- 1/4 yard Medium weight fusible interfacing
- 1/2 yard 1/2" wide grosgrain ribbon
- 1 1/2" Velcro

## Bow Tie

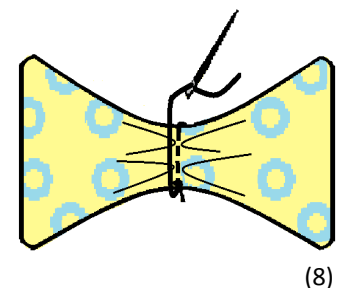
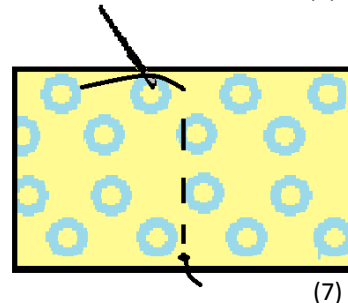
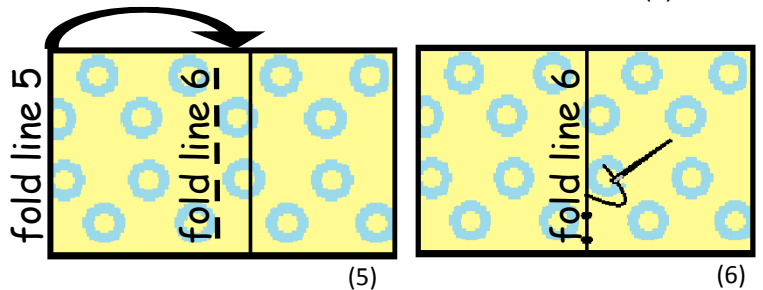
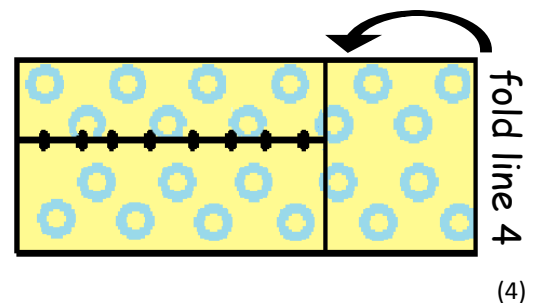
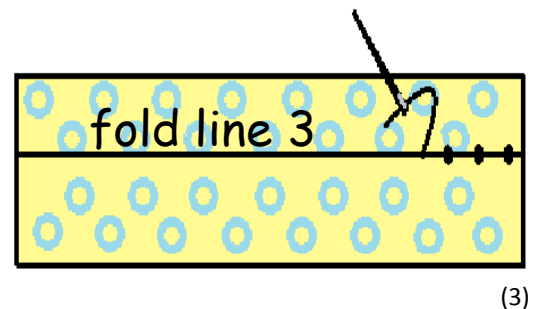
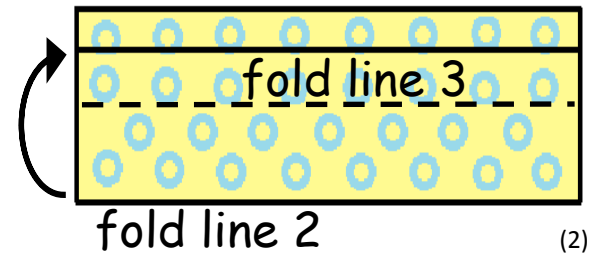
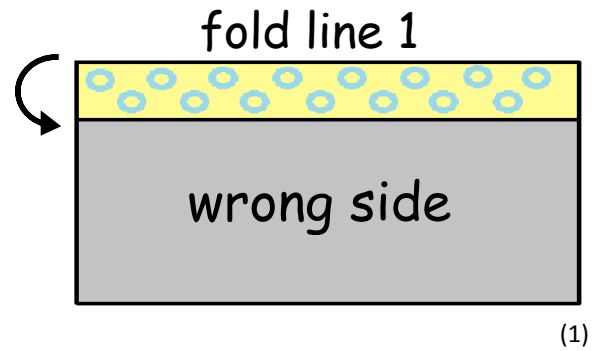
- When using a necktie open up the seams and press flat using a medium heat setting on the iron.
- Check the placement of your pattern pieces on the fabric before cutting out. Example: Will the snowman's head be cut off?

Cut out bow tie pieces and interfacing. Using a medium setting on the iron, press the interfacing to the wrong side of each bow tie piece.

On the bow tie piece press along fold line 1 and 2 to the wrong side of the fabric. (Fig.1 & 2) Turn under raw edge along fold line 3 press and pin in place. Using a hand sewing needle slip stitch along fold line 3 only stitching through the top layers of fabric. (Fig.3)

Press the tie along fold line 4 to the back side of the tie. (Fig.4) Press the tie along fold line 5 to the back side of the tie. (Fig.5) Turn under raw edge along fold line 6 press and pin in place. Using a hand sewing needle slip stitch along fold line 6 only stitching through the top layers of fabric (Fig.6)

Turn the bow tie right side up and mark the center. Using a 1/2" long running stitch, stitch through all layers of the tie. (Fig.7) Pull the stitches up tight and wrap the thread around the center of the tie twice and tie off. (Fig.8)



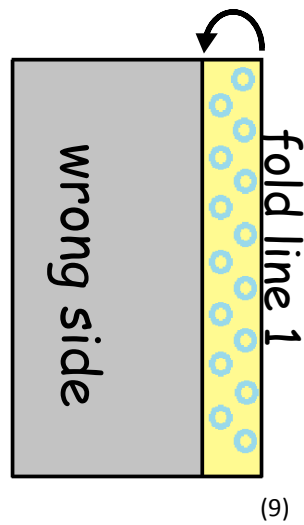
## Bow Tie Center Knot

On the bow tie piece press along fold line 1 and 2 to the wrong side of the fabric. (Fig.9 & 10) Turn under raw edge along fold line 3 press and pin in place. Using a hand sewing needle slip stitch along fold line 3 only stitching through the top layers of fabric. (Fig.11)

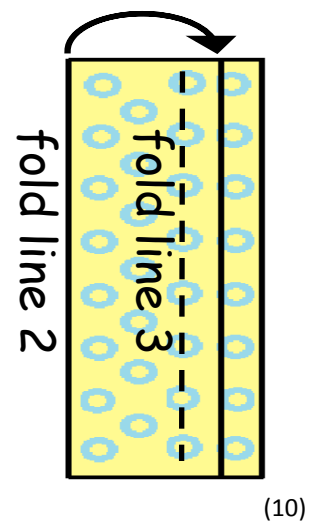
Wrong sides up, place the bow tie in the center of the bow tie knot. Press the Bow Tie Knot along fold line 4 to the back side of the tie. (Fig.12) Press the tie along fold line 5 to the back side of the tie. Turn under raw edge along fold line 6 press and pin in place. Using a hand sewing needle slip stitch along fold line 6 only stitching through the top layers of fabric (Fig.13)

Cut a piece of grosgrain ribbon 15" long. Attach a safety pin at one end of the ribbon and run the ribbon between the bow tie knot and the bow tie. (Fig.14)

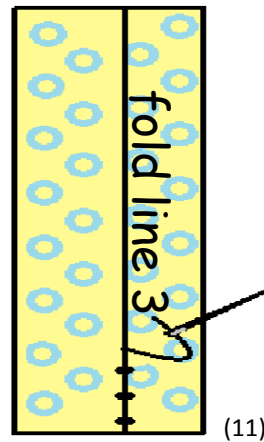
Turn under 1/2" on each end of the ribbon to the wrong side and press. Stitch 1-1/2" piece of Velcro close to the ends on the right side at one end and on the wrong side at the other. (Fig.15)



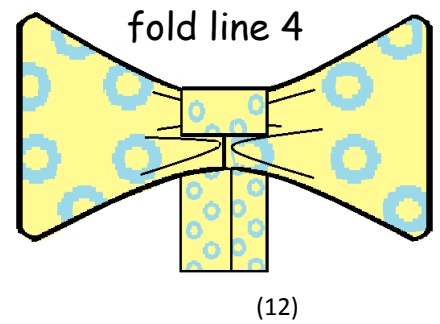
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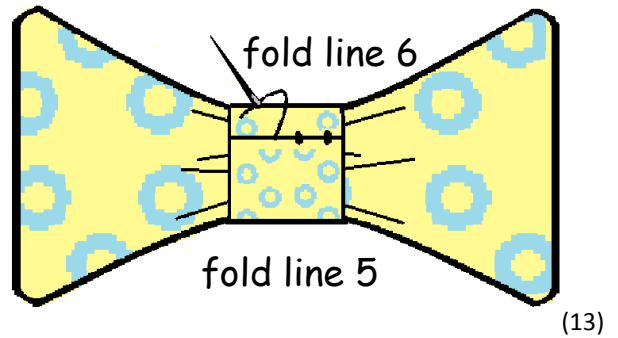
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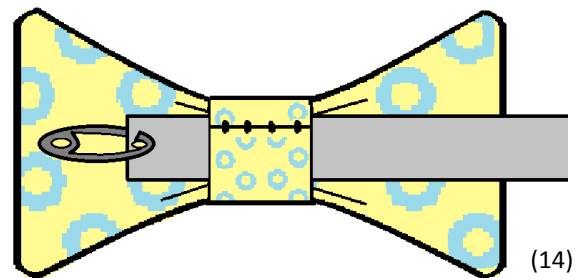
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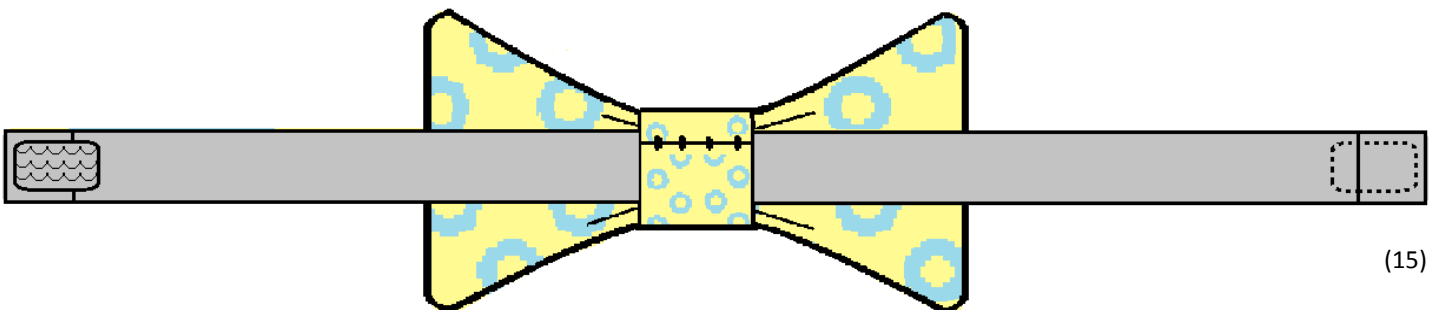
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
