



We specialise in creating customised perfect brows for your face shape, skin colour and skin type. Each brow we create is as unique as the guest. Our tattooing techniques are natural, giving you flawless brows every day without the need for makeup. Whether you prefer a perfectly manicured, strong brow or just need some light shading to fill sparse areas, our brow tattoo experts have got you covered!



- Cosmetic tattooing procedure(s) require multiple treatment sessions. It is **IMPERATIVE** you complete the touchup “perfection visit” treatment. Without it, the results will not be optimal and considered incomplete.

For best results, clients will be required to return for *lease* (one)1 touch-up appointment. This will take place between 4 to 6 weeks after the initial procedure. The Touch up “perfection visit” corrects any irregularities in the microbladed hair strokes, color tones and finishes the process.

****Occasionally a third touch up (4-6 weeks later) is necessary for certain clients where the pigment does not take as well to the skin.****



Microblading

Microblading, also known as eyebrow embroidery, microstroking, feather touch and hair like strokes, is a type of permanent makeup that allows wearers to partially or fully camouflage missing eyebrow hair with the appearance of simulated hair using fine deposits of cosmetic tattoo pigments.

How long does it take?

The first microblading session will take between 1 - 2 hours. This session involves choosing the brow shape, style and color to meet the guest's goals. The procedure will begin once we have a clear, mutual understanding. The next session will be a follow up session about 4 -6 weeks later for touch ups.

How long does it last?

Depending on skin type, microblading typically lasts between 18 and 24 months before beginning to gently fade. Touch ups are recommended about every 12 – 18 months to maintain the desired look.

How is microblading performed?

Microblading is done using a hand tool that is outfitted with a single use "blade" used to create thin hair like marks in the skin. Your artist will choose needles and the blade type according to the technique and the skin type. The pigment is bladed just below the epidermis and the most shallow part of the dermis, making extremely fine natural looking hair strokes. A very natural result is achieved, as the hairs are bladed into the skin according to the natural hair growth direction.



Does Microblading hurt?

Most individuals classify microblading as a low to moderate discomfort procedure, although each individual may experience a different level of discomfort. Topical anesthetics are used before and during the procedure to ensure your comfort.

What is the recovery for microblading?

Your new eyebrows will go through several phases during the healing cycle. True reflection of healed color can only be assessed 3-4 weeks after treatment. Touch-ups and/ or correction of the shape/ design is recommended at least 4 weeks after initial treatment. It will go from too dark, to too light, to just right!

Immediately after the procedure, the pigment will appear very sharp and dark. This is because the pigment is still seating on top of your skin and has not yet settled in completely. The color of the pigment will soften gradually (do not be alarmed if you see some pigment on the cotton swab as this is excess pigment and/or body fluid that is naturally exiting your skin).

Once the healing of the skin starts taking place it will look like dandruff flakes or dry skin. This might give you the impression that the color pigment is fading too quickly. However, this is just superficial color and dry skin being naturally removed from your eyebrows. Your eyebrows will be the lightest tones during days 5-12 because the color is absorbed in the deeper layers of the skin. Later skin cells push it back to the upper layers. Once the healing is completed, you will enjoy a pair of beautiful, new, natural looking eyebrows.



Where do I start?


Microblading requires a consultation before the procedure to make sure we clearly communicate all information about the process and customize the procedure to you considering that there is more than one route.

OMBRE BROWS

The ombre effect comes from using two different colors, one lighter than the other. It is more natural

looking than solid colour and is the latest thing in eyebrow semi-permanent make up. Ombre brows are designed by skilfully gradually blending your eyebrows from a light centre to dark end, creating a sharp yet natural looking brow. Ombre brows can be used to create a soft shadow of colour, creating similar result that are achieved with an eyebrow pencil/powder and is best for those looking to achieve similar results, perfect for creating a more solid, powder filled brow look. This technique is a great option for any age and skin type, especially people with oily skin types.

LASTS LONGER: Results do vary based on lifestyle, skin type, health, references, etc., but a single ombré powder brows session, using high-quality pigments, can last on average 2-3 years.






Ombre Brow /Blade & Shade



Handblade or Machine

Hair strokes are created at the bulb to midline with a powdering/peppering effect building density toward a defined tail. A handheld blade, machine or combination of both tools are used. Great for clients with no hair, oily skin, or those wanting more density with microblading.





Soft make-up like effect is created using a handheld blade or machine to powder the entire brow. Great for clients with no hair, previously tattooed eyebrows, oily skin & those seeking longevity.

CASHMERE BROWS

Cashmere Brows is a combination of microblading technique and the ombre shading method. Just like cashmere these eyebrows are soft and luxurious. With a blend of both feather touch and ombre techniques to create the perfect brow that's both natural and defined for the ultimate luxe brows!

Is there anything I need todo to prepare for my service?

- Do not drink coffee, alcohol or energizing drinks on the day of treatment.
- Do not take Aspirin, Niacin, Vitamin E or Ibuprofen 24 hours before treatment.
- Do not take omega3 (fish oil) 1 week before treatment.
- Do not tan or have intense sun exposure 3 days before treatment.
- No waxing 2-3 days before treatment.
- No chemical peels, dermabrasion, laser or any other intense treatments 2 weeks before treatment.
- Shower and fix your hair as you need to take extra care not to get your brows wet for several days.



Is there any aftercare Procedure?

Yes! Make sure to avoid ALL of the following:

- Increased sweating, practicing sports, swimming, hot sauna, hot bath or jacuzzi, sun tanning or salon tanning.
- Picking, peeling or scratching of the micro pigmented area; in order to avoid scarring of the area or removal of the pigment.
- Performing tasks related to heavy household cleaning such as garage or basement cleaning where there is a lot of airborne debris.
- Touching of the eyebrow area except for when rinsing and applying the post-care cream with a cotton swab.
- Before showering apply a layer of post-care cream to protect your eyebrows from moisture. During the shower keep your face away from the shower head.



Once completely healed, always apply a layer of sunscreen SPF 30 on your eyebrows when exposed to the sun. Sun exposure might cause the color pigment to fade away more quickly. Brows will require continued moisturizing for 3 weeks keeping the pigmented skin moist with our specialty formulated oil based balm.

**** Itching and flaking may appear during the first seven days post microblading procedure, However, experience has shown that by following these aftercare instructions these symptoms may quickly disappear ****
