DIRECTIONS TO April's Maple VIA the Quickest Route from Island Pond

(These directions take in consideration logging closures and is the most direct route.)

Distance is 28 miles +/-

- Starting point is Brighton Snowmobile Club's Intersection EX242. This location is in the park pavilion area between Irving Gas Station and Kingdom Grille across from Dollar General.
- 2. Follow Trail 114c along the shore of Island Pond to EX24 (Dave Page Memorial). *At one mile stay left at fork up hill.
 - (Distance between EX242 to EX24 is 2.3 miles).
- At EX24 turn RIGHT onto Trail 114 to EX22 (Distance between EX24 and EX22 is 2.5 miles).
- 4. At EX22 turn LEFT onto Trail 114c/102c. Continue passing intersection EX32 to EX33. At EX33 bear left to EX294. (Distance between EX22 to EX294 is 4.7 miles).
- 5. At EX294 turn RIGHT onto Trail 114a to EX293. (Distance between EX 294 to EX293 is 1 mile).
- 6. At EX293 turn RIGHT onto trail 102 passing EX271 to EX17. (Distance between EX293 to EX17 is 5.2 miles).
- 7. At EX17 turn RIGHT onto Trail 102 to EX172. (Distance is 0.2 miles).
- 8. At EX172 turn LEFT onto Trail 102 to EX173. (Distance is 0.5 miles).
- 9. At EX173 turn RIGHT onto Trail 106c to EX110 (Distance is 1.9 miles).
- 10. At EX110 turn LEFT onto Trail 106 to EX101. (Distance is 4.9 miles).
- 11. At EX101 turn LEFT onto Trail 106 to EX10. (Distance is 0.7 miles).
- 12. At EX10 turn RIGHT onto Trail 105 passing EX105 to EX7. (Distance is 2.9 miles).
- 13. At EX7 turn RIGHT onto Trail 105 to EX611. (Distance is 0.2 miles).
- 14. At EX611 turn LEFT onto Trail 103 to April's Maple Access secondary trail 103F. There are April's Maple Signs to guide you. (Distance is 1.5 miles).
