

Two-Piece Favor Box with Ribbon

Assembling the bottom:

- Open the folded box bottom into a square. Press flat the four flaps on the bottom and interlock to lay flat.
- Tuck in the top three shorter flaps, folding the scored sections into the base of the box.
- Tuck in the long flap, folding it at the scored mark and press down into bottom of box.
- Line the inside of the box and fill with treats. If using wrapped treats, lining is optional.



Assembling the lid:

- With the decorative side down, crease the diagonal scored lines in toward the center of the lid.
- Fold along horizontal scored lines and tuck in the short flap, pressing the scored mark into the fold.
- Tuck in the long flap, pressing the scored mark into the fold. Insert the notched tab into the open slot of the short flap.



Adding the ribbon:

- Locate the pre-punched holes on two sides of the box.
- Loosely thread included, pre-cut ribbon coming from the outside of lid through one hole.
- Bring ribbon across to opposite hole and pull through.
- Take the longer piece of ribbon and loop back over side of lid, threading ribbon back through the first hole. The result is the two ribbon ends will be on the same side of the lid. It is recommended to use a bobby pin or large needle to make threading ribbon easier.
- Take filled box bottom and place inside ribbon loop, fitting it into the lid.
- Carefully pull ribbons tight, gently pulling on each ribbon to get them the approximately the same length.
- Tie the ribbon in a double knot to complete favor.
