For some children, the sheer volume of stimuli in a busy school can be a sensory overload, making it a stressful and disturbing place. Creating a sensory room in a school is a practical and effective way to provide a calming and safe space for neurodivergent children including those with sensory processing difficulties.

Sensory spaces can have many benefits, they can:

- Provide a calming, relaxing, stress-free environment to support children's mental health and wellbeing
- Improve levels of concentration, alertness, calmness, and general awareness
- Support social, motor, and tactile development and essential sensory skills like handeye coordination and cause and effect
- Create a space for children to become more acquainted with themselves and their five senses.



We also sell a range of pop up sensory dens that are designed to offer a more accessible alternative to a permanent sensory room. They are portable, light and affordable.



A sensory room transformation!

We recently helped Boreham Primary School in Essex transform a dull room into a calming and relaxing sensory space for children with additional needs to explore. Take a look at the before and after photos below, it's quite the transformation!

The children are absolutely delighted with the sensory toys and accessories and have called the space the 'Dragon's nest' in honour of the school mascot Susan the Dragon.







The aim of the room is to help children feel calm and focused, helping them feel better prepared for learning and interacting with their peers. Parents have told the school that their child's access to the new sensory room and equipment has improved family life at home too!





Concentration aids advice

Children who find it difficult to concentrate in a learning environment may benefit from sensory toys and aids to harness their attention. Here are some of our top tips:



Tangles and fidget toys

Tangles and fidget toys can aid concentration and reduce anxiety by providing additional stimulation for sensory seekers. They come in a variety of forms including metal tangles, stretchy string, bubble toys and maze toys.



Having a visual representation of their day can reduce anxieties and frustrations for children with SEN by making it easier to understand, follow, and remember what they need to do. Like this TomTag school timetable sticker pack, which contains 72 symbols to use for structuring the school day and explaining what to expect.







Timers

Timers are great for developing concentration skills – providing a way to judge how much time is left, without having to know how to tell the time. Perfect for setting time limits for tasks and activities to prevent them from getting bored.







Sensory cushions

Sensory cushions are great for children that have trouble sitting still in class – helping them focus for longer. This <u>sloped cushion</u> can provide sensory feedback and calm fidgeters, or this vibrating <u>Senseez cushion</u> is a great filter for over stimulation, simply sit on it, hug it or squeeze it to start the vibration!



Ear defenders

<u>Ear defenders</u> are great for children with autism and sensory processing issues, who are sensitive to noise and certain sounds. Great for settling children who are disturbed by a noisy environment.







Weighted products

Weighted products like this <u>weighted lap pad</u> can have a calming effect by applying a deep pressure to the lap whilst sat down – helping improve attention span and reducing fidgeting.


