- Cash payments won't be accepted for the time being. We will accept credit card payments, Zelle and ACH, as well as other payment forms.

Preventive measures taken by our team:

- Mandatory hand washing every hour

- Limit gathering size to smallest groups needed.
- Our warehouse doors will remain open to avoid handle contact.
- We doubled our cleaning efforts
- We placed signs around the office to create awareness to our customers and employees
- Forbidden the use of water fountains.
