DIY Cactus Paper Garland with Milky Pop Pens

Pentel's Milky Pop Pens come in 7 different bright and beautiful colors (including white). These gel pens have a matte, chalky appearance when the ink dries, making them look fantastic on white paper, colored paper, and even black paper.

SUPPLIES:

- Scissors
- Milky Pop Pens
- Cardstock: we used 1 sheet of light green, 1 sheet of dark green, 1 sheet of yellow, 1 sheet of pink, and 1 sheet of blue
- Baker's twine, or other cotton twine, roughly 6 feet total
- Plant template attached here
- Tape
- Optional: Glue Stick
- •

STEPS:

- 1. Print out template, and cut out the template's shapes.
- 2. Using the cut-out templates, trace the shapes on to the different colors of paper.
- 3. Cut out the shapes. You maybe be able to cut 2 or 3 pieces of paper at a time, to make the work faster. We cut 6 cactus shapes out of green, and 6 total plant pot shapes, using pink, yellow, and blue. (photo)
- 4. Decorate the pots and plants. We used a variety of patterns, like polka dots, stripes, and chevrons. You'll notice how smooth the ink glides onto the page, and how solid and opaque the ink looks when it dries.
- 5. Tape the pots onto the cacti, or, you can use a glue stick to glue the pots onto the plants.
- 6. Tape the backside of the cut-out plants to the string, taping at the top area. Space the plants about 6 inches apart from one another.
- 7. Step back and admire your cute new festive garland!
