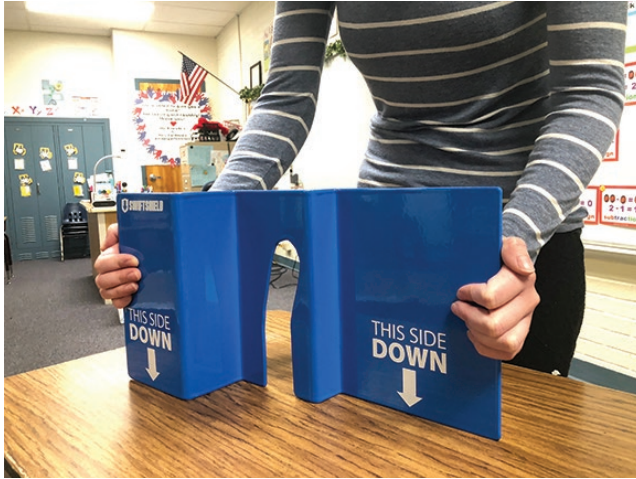




## HOW TO PROPERLY USE YOUR DEVICE FOR MAXIMUM SAFETY.

### Step 1.



Pick up SwiftShield™ from its predestinated, easy to access, location, and make your way to the door you're intending to secure. Ensure you can see the graphics on the front of your SwiftShield™, and the arrows are pointing down.

### Step 2.



Slide your SwiftShield™ over the door handle ensuring it goes down as far as it will allow, then follow your predetermined lock down procedures.

### Step 3.



Your door is now secure.

Please ensure you have the correct SwiftShield™ device for all doors you wish to ensure safety for in the event of a crisis. Each SwiftShield™ is manufactured to fit the intended door based off three specific aspects. 1. The length from the door to the door frame. 2. Type of door knob (ADA or Standard) 3. ## WARNINGS

SwiftShield™ is not intended for regular use in lieu of a standard door lock.

SwiftShield™ is measured to be compatible with the specific door for which it is purchased. It is not intended to be used on doors other than the specific door for which it is purchased. There is no guarantee that SwiftShield™ will work properly, or as intended, on additional doors.

While SwiftShield™ is made from high quality materials, nothing is indestructible; care should be taken to make sure your SwiftShield™ is not damaged, dropped, broken, cracked or destroyed prior to, or during use.

Do not allow SwiftShield™ to be exposed to extreme heat or cold for extended periods of time.

Care should be taken when storing your SwiftShield™ to assure that it is not accessible to unauthorized users or those intending to use the SwiftShield™ in an incorrect manner or for an improper purpose.

### **Limited Warranty**

SwiftShield™ has a Limited Warranty to cover any manufacturer's defects in material or workmanship under normal use during the Warranty Period of twenty-four (24) months from the date of Your purchase ("Warranty Period").
