Surmise[®] Pro is a postemergence, non-selective, herbicide for the control of broadleaf weeds and grasses. A group 10 herbicide (glutamine synthetase inhibitor), **Surmise Pro** is a foliar-active material with little or no soil-residual activity. Visual results showing necrosis of leaves and young shoots occur within 2 to 4 days after application under good growing conditions.

Surmise Pro is rainfast four (4) hours after application to most weed species; therefore, rainfall within four (4) hours may necessitate retreatment or may result in reduced weed control.

- Lower use rates versus glyphosate.
- Provides control of a wide variety of emerged annual and perennial broadleaf weeds and grasses.
- Reduced translocation enables ability to create and maintain clear boundaries around golf turf, sand traps, and athletic fields and accurate application areas around existing ornamentals in landscape beds.
- Effective pre-plant treatment for turf, ornamentals, and greenhouses due to minimal soil residual.
- Excellent tank-mix partner with preemergence herbicides such as proflam, oryzalin, and oxadiazon.
- Excellent rotation herbicide for managing existing or developing resistance issues.
