

PRO TIPS



To keep gel fresh, store jagua bottle in fridge when not in use. Will last for 3 months.



When ready to use, transfer jagua gel to applicator bottle. Use caution when handling jagua, it stains the skin rapidly. Screw on top + tip of choice and you're ready to create!



For the darkest stain, apply gel to areas with thick skin such as palms of hands and feet.



The longer you leave on the jagua gel (2-6 hours), the darker your stain will be and the longer it will last.



Be sure to correct smudges and mistakes as quickly as possible. The jagua is fast acting and will leave a stain that you won't be happy with the following day.



For best results keep area with your tattoo still for 30 minutes while your gel dries to a crackly state. Once dry, leave on for at least 2 hours for good color.



If using a sticker stencil, cut to size and press firmly on desired area. For parts of sticker not sitting well, cut slits to allow it to bend and lay flat on the skin. Next get in a comfortable position, fill in stencil with an even layer of jagua gel and let it dry before moving too much.



After the sticker and dry gel are removed, you will have a barely visible tattoo. The color will continue to darken till it reaches a deep blue/black color within 48 hours.



Tattoos will last for 1 - 2 weeks, depending on how often you bathe, exfoliate and expose your skin to water and chlorine.



Wash applicator tips with warm water after each use to prevent clogging.



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
