

Survival Kits

The Crew Survival System is a two-person, 48 hour, modular survival ruck designed to replace heavier legacy aircrew survival kits. Weighing only 23 pounds, the system contains three modules: sustainment (LIRSH), medical, and survival. The contents have been thoroughly reviewed and independently tested by the 160th US Army Special Operations Aviation Regiment (SOAR).

Features and Specifications

Stowable shoulder straps to reduce snag hazards.

Carabiner attachment points for connection to aircraft.

Expandable 8" compartment increases bag volume.

Quick access "dump pouch" for E&E situations. Module 1 (sustainment): two-year shelf life.

Module 2 & 3: unlimited shelf life.


