

# Actiwash for Tarmacadam

The structure of Tarmacadam and its surrounding environment can function as an attractive host to the formation of biofilms - particularly moss and algae. The development of these growths on Tarmacadam can be visually unsightly, deleterious to the material itself and potentially assemble into a slip hazard.

## Application

- Dilute Actiwash in accordance to the recommendations prescribed on the product label.
- Apply Actiwash by spray (knapsack, mechanical sprayer) or pour (watering can) onto the affected area.
- Allow up to two weeks for the moss to turn orange/brown.
- Once the moss has changed colour and has started to decompose, the heavy deposits can be easily swept away with a general yard brush.
- Apply a final application of Actiwash onto the area and leave. This will help (in conjunction with prevailing weather) to eliminate small moss deposits which can be difficult to sweep up. This final spray also helps to promote for longer lasting results.

## Advice

- Apply Actiwash on a dry day in temperatures above 7 degrees Celsius.
- Keep pets and children away from the surface until dry.
- Sweep up moss deposits on a dry day.
