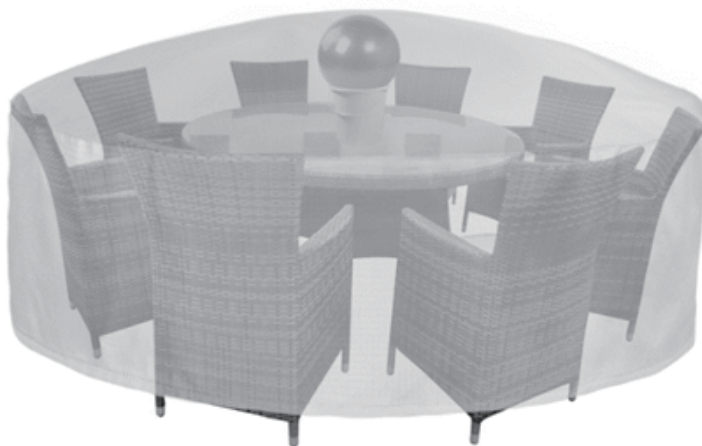
Shield Outdoor Covers are manufactured with high quality, solution-dyed polyester, laminated with Shield membrane. The covers offer optimum protections to your garden furniture and barbeque grills against the sun, rain, snow, and dirt in general.

Before putting the cover on, please make sure the inside is as dry as possible to prevent locking moisture inside. With temperature variations, condensation is unavoidable. Although our covers are made of material that is breathable and we have vent windows installed on the thicker covers, it's highly recommended that you take the covers off regularly to allow it to air, preferably weekly.

After the cover is on, strap the clips around the legs of furniture and tighten the drawstrings to secure it from being blown away.

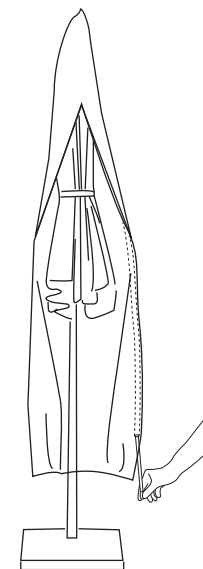
Creating A Pinnacle

To avoid water puddles being formed, try to create a highest point or pinnacle to allow water to run off the cover. With large table set covers, we recommend a plastic bucket and ball setup in the middle of the table to form such pinnacle (illustrated on the right) . This setup is better than most cover supporting poles on the marketplace.



Umbrella Cover

You will find a pole in the umbrella cover package. This pole, after assembled, can help you to put the cover on or off the closed umbrella easily, which can be too tall to reach otherwise (illustrated on the right).



Maintenance Tips: use soap and wet cloth to clean the cover before storage. Never put the cover in washing machines, which can damage the waterproof membrane.
