



THE DIFFERENCE IN QUALITY

Economy, Economy Plus or Premium

The Economy Plus and Premium Range are made using Anodised Aluminium which is stronger than the Economy Range Steel doors and tracks and can be used in all internal environments unlike steel systems which we would not advise be used in or adjacent to any areas of humidity.

The Economy Plus and Premium Range is gasketed providing a buffer between the glass and the metal resulting in a stronger more robust door.

The Economy Plus and Premium Ranges have higher specification (ball bearing based) bottom running and top guiding wheels leading to a smoother and quieter run on the tracks.

The tracks top and bottom are also narrower and more sleek in the Economy Plus and Premium Ranges.

Door positioners come as standard in the Economy Plus and Premium Ranges (unless you have Soft Close) and are not available in the Economy Steel system, (neither is Soft Close).

These give the doors a positive closure.

Each door in the Premium Range has a rebated soft brush edging strip for quieter closure against each other or wall.

Economy Steel doors are a high value steel system but without all those benefits listed above in the Premium range.

Its like two cars of a different classification – a Jaguar or a Fiesta. Each gets from A to B and works well in different ways and is a different price reflecting the perceived qualities/value.
