CARE GUIDE

ROOME LONDON's furniture is made to order by the master craftspeople at Shamsian. With bold imaginative designs we create high quality pieces that are as beautiful as they are functional. The collection is handcrafted using the highest quality materials and naturally occurring variations making each piece unique. Grain variation is an inherent characteristic of wood and its colour will change over time. Likewise natural veneers, solid metal finishes and textiles age beautifully over time. Please refer to our care instructions to ensure longevity of each design detail.

GENERAL CARE TIPS

- Avoid dragging ROOME LONDON furniture, this can damage the legs and finishes. Always lift when moving.
- Avoid ROOME LONDON furniture being exposed to prolonged sunlight, this can fade textiles and other design details over time.
- Avoid any sharp objects or edges coming into contact with the furniture, this can scrape or chip the woodwork and finishes.
- Avoid chemicals being used on surfaces.

WOOD FINISH

ROOME LONDON uses master craftspeople to craft and build each piece. Ash wood is given a lacquered finish that is hard-wearing and gives protection against moisture and spills.

How to care for wood veneer?

- Use a dry clean cloth to dust regularly. ROOME LONDON does not recommend using any polishing products or sprays.
- Wipe up any spills using a damp cloth, then use a dry cloth immediately after.
- Avoid putting any hot items on surfaces, use mats or coasters to protect from moisture and heat.
- Avoid any sharp objects that can chip the woodwork and finish.

BRASS COATED / BRASS FRAMES LEGS AND HANDLES.

ROOME LONDON's master craftspeople solid brass and coated brass designs details that are intricately moulded for its handles, legs and frames. Both solid brass and brass coated details offer a sleek and hard wearing finish.

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How to care for brass coated/solid details?

- Wipe using a microfibre or soft cloth, wipe regularly handles and legs.
- Avoid using any chemicals, this can tarnish or strip the finish.
- Be mindful of any sharp objects scratching or denting surfaces.

HAND EMBROIDERY

Elevating the time-honoured art of upholstery the hand embroidered facades are expertly applied to the cabinetry and can be altered over time to suit changing moods and design themes.

How to care for hand embroidery?

- Keep the embroidery out of strong sunlight for long periods. Embroidery can fade in prolonged sunlight so be mindful of its positioning.
- If the fabric becomes wet, dry off with a soft cloth and leave to dry fully.
- Avoid scrubbing or using any chemicals that can stain.
- Avoid any sharp objects that can tear the fabric or cause laddering.
- Gentle vacuuming a couple of times a year will extend the life of the textiles. A low power held vacuum cleaner is an ideal tool for this task. Ideally this should be in conjunction with a fine mesh net over the nozzle, to ensure that the delicate embroidery is not pulled or damaged. Vacuum carefully, working in the direction of the nap when cleaning velvets, and taking care that the net and nozzle do not catch on the thread or beadwork.
- When handling light fabrics, care must be taken always to ensure that hands are completely clean and free from contamination, dirt, acids and perspiration.
- We use high performance backing fabrics throughout the collection and our handles feature backplates to protect the textile element of the design when opening doors but it is always advisable to consult a specialist cleaner to discuss suitable processes if the embroidery is in need of cleaning.
