



Heritage Quilting Cruise Supply List

We will provide you with the following:

- Bernina sewing machine
- Quarter-inch foot
- Neutral cotton thread for class
- Bobbins
- Full-size irons
- Small trash bags for fabric scraps
- Power cords
- Sail 'n Sew Kits for those who purchased the pre-cut kits.

You need to bring:

- Basic Sewing Supplies:
 - Small scissors and/or thread snips. Scissors cannot be over 4" blade length
 - Rotary cutter with fresh blades
 - Seam ripper and seam roller
 - Your favorite pins and pin cushion
 - Stiletto or Purple Thang
 - A small cutting mat (18" x 24" is recommended) or a Cut 'n Press
 - Basic rulers: 6" x 12" or your favorite size
 - Marking pens and/or pencils for light and dark fabrics
- Optional – but recommended items:
 - Quart and gallon-size baggies for unfinished pieces
 - Mini rotating cutting mat
 - A task light (Ott-light type tabletop lamp)
 - Small personal craft iron – Maximum 420W
Oliso mini-irons are prohibited
 - Small ironing surface to have next to your machine if you are bringing a small craft Iron
 - Small spray bottle to provide moisture for our dry irons

*Quilt Specific Supplies

You must bring these quilt-specific tools in order to successfully complete your quilt top. These tools are NOT included in any SNS kit.
