## All Roads Lead To The Sea (Section \#13 Fence \#14 Strip and Finishing)

## Pattern by Country Creations

Note: Fabrics will be different then fabrics in your package. I recommend doing a fabric key in the colors you are using.

Congratulations you have made it to the end!!
Section \#13 (Fence)
On this one you have options. You can either cut all the pieces or do strips.
If you want to piece it, you will need Fence pieces (16) $4 \frac{1}{2} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ and (30) $1 \frac{1}{2} \times 3 \frac{1}{2}$ and Background pieces (30) $1 \times 31 / 2$ and (15) $1 \frac{1}{2} \times 31 / 2$. Piece together as shown.

I chose the alternative method of making strip sets. For this method, you will make 3 sets using the longest side or WOF of Background 1 inch, Fence $1 \frac{1}{2}$ inch, Background $1 \frac{1}{2}$ inch, Fence $1 \frac{1}{2}$ inch and Background 1 inch.


Subcut the strip set at $31 / 2$ inches. Make 15 subcuts. Sew fence post between each subset and on ends. Set aside for quilt assembly.


Section\#14 (Dark Grass same as background to fence)
Cut $21 / 2 \times 611 / 2$ and set aside for quilt assembly.

Quilt Assembly:

1. Sew Block 1 (Trees), Block 2 (Cottage) and Block 3 (Lighthouse) together.
2. Sew Block 4 (Cabin), Block 5 (Sea Edge) and Block 6 (Ocean / Top of Church) together.
3. Sew 7 (House) to Block 10 (Schoolhouse) together.
4. Sew Block 8 (Top of General Store) to Block 9 (Church).
5. Sew Block 11 (Bottom of General Store) to Block 12 (Barn).

See picture. Each step shown in boxes.


Next you will be combining the blocks as follows:

1. Top row to second row.
2. Top of General Store/Church to Bottom of General Store/Barn.

3. Add the Schoolhouse Section to the General Store/Church/Barn Section.
4. Take the section from step 1 and combine it with the top part of the quilt (Cottage/Lighthouse/Cabin)
5. Take step 2 and add Section \#13 (Fence) and Section \#14 (Dark Grass - Background to Fence).


## Borders:

Note: Page 8 of the pattern states the quilt is $61^{\prime \prime} \times 72^{\prime \prime}$ Before Borders. That is the projected size without Sections 13 and 14.

Since all quilts come out slightly off, I would suggest measuring the ends and middle and take the average. The length I cut the inner and outer border may be slightly different depending on exact size of your quilt.

Inner Border:

1. Cut (8) strips $2 \frac{1}{2}$ for the inner border.

I started with the sides and I got $781 / 2$ for the sides and then I finished with the top and bottom. That measured to be $651 / 2$ on my quilt. Please measure your quilt to find the length you need to make your strips.

Outer Border:

1. Cut (9) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide strips for the sides, top and bottom of outer border.
2. I started with the sides and I got $821 / 2$ for the sides and then I finished with the top and bottom. That measured to be $781 / 2$ on my quilt. Please measure your quilt to find the length you need to make your strips.

This top is now ready to be quilted as desired!
