

## **Fabrics and Cutting Chart**

Fabrics	Yardage	Cutting Directions
Fabric A R2211-Cream	2 1/2y	a. Pieced blocks (12) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (80) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares and (160) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles. (5) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (80) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles.
		b. Sashing blocks (8) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Reserve for strip piecing.
		c. Cornerstones (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Reserve for strip piecing. (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 1 ½" x 3 ½" rectangles.
		d. Inner border (6) 2" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 2" x 52 ½" and (2) 2" x 62 ½" strips.
Fabric B R2202-Med Blue	1y	a. Pieced blocks (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (32) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares. (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares, (8) 2 ½" x 3 ½" and (8) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles.
		b. Outer border (7) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3 ½" x 58 ½" and (2) 3 ½" x 65 ½" strips.
Fabric C R2204-Navy	1/4y	a. Pieced blocks (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (32) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares. (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares, (8) 2 ½" x 3 ½" and (8) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles.
Fabric D R2205-Navy	1/4y	a. Pieced blocks (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (32) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares. (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares, (8) 2 ½" x 3 ½" and (8) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles.

Fabric E R2206-Grey	7/8y	<ul> <li>a. Sashing blocks</li> <li>(16) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Reserve for strip piecing.</li> <li>b. Cornerstones</li> <li>(2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Reserve for strip piecing.</li> </ul>
Fabric F R2206-Navy	1/4y	a. Pieced blocks (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (32) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares. (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares, (8) 2 ½" x 3 ½" and (8) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles.
Fabric G R2207-Blue	1/4y	a. Pieced blocks (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (32) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares. (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares, (8) 2 ½" x 3 ½" and (8) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles.
Fabric H R2207-Lt Blue	1/4y	a. Pieced blocks (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (32) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares. (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares, (8) 2 ½" x 3 ½" and (8) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles.
Fabric I R2208-Blue	1/4y	a. Pieced blocks (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (32) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares. (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares, (8) 2 ½" x 3 ½" and (8) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles.
Fabric J R2209-Blue	1/4y	a. Pieced blocks (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (32) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares. (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares, (8) 2 ½" x 3 ½" and (8) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles.
Fabric K R2210-Navy	1/4y	a. Pieced blocks (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (32) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares. (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares, (8) 2 ½" x 3 ½" and (8) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles.
Fabric L R2211-Blue	1/4y	a. Pieced blocks (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (32) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares. (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares, (8) 2 ½" x 3 ½" and (8) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles.

#### **Constructing Pieced Blocks**

1. Flying geese unit. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1 ½" x 1 ½" **Blue Print** square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 1 ½" x 2 ½" **Fabric A** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim ¼" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 1 ½" x 1 ½" **Blue Print** square at the opposite corner of the same **Fabric A** rectangle to complete (1) flying geese unit.



Make a total of (2) units.


2. Sew (1) flying geese unit above (1) 1 ½" x 2 ½" **Blue Print** rectangle.




Then sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric A** square to the left of previously sewn unit to make a row unit. Row unit measures  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



3. Sew (1) flying geese unit to the left of (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" **Blue Print** rectangle to make a row unit. Row unit measures 2 ½" x 4 ½" unfinished.




4. Sew together row units made in steps 2 and 3 to make (1) block quadrant.




Make a total of (4) quadrants.


5. Sew (2) quadrants to the opposite long sides of (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" *Fabric A* rectangle to make a row unit.



6. Sew (2) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A rectangles to the opposite sides of (1) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Blue Print square to make a row unit.



7. Sew together row units to made in steps 5 and 6 to complete (1) pieced block.



8. Make a total of (2) blocks for the following *Blue Prints* for a total of (20) blocks. Fabric B, C, D, F, G, H, I, J, K, L

#### **Constructing Sashing Blocks**

1. Sew (2) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF *Fabric E* strips to the opposite long sides of (1) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF *Fabric A* strip. Subcut strip set at 10  $\frac{1}{2}$ " intervals for (4) sashing blocks. Block measures 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10  $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.




Repeat to make a total of (31) sashing blocks.

#### **Constructing Cornerstones**

1. Sew (2) 1 ½" x WOF *Fabric E* strips to the opposite long sides of (1) 1 ½" x WOF *Fabric A* strip. Subcut strip set at 1 ½" intervals for (24) units. Unit measures 1 ½" x 3 ½" unfinished.




2. Sew two units from step 1 to the opposite long sides of (1) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A rectangle to complete (1) cornerstone. Cornerstone measures 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



Make a total of (12) cornerstones.

#### **Quilt Center Assembly**


1. Pieced rows. Arrange and sew together (4) pieced blocks and (3) sashing blocks to make a pieced row. Make a total of (5) pieced rows. Row 1 is shown below.



2. Pieced sashing rows. Arrange and sew together (4) sashing blocks and (3) cornerstones to make a pieced sashing row. Make a total of (4) pieced sashing rows.




3. Sew together pieced rows and pieced sashing rows to complete quilt center.



### **Quilt Top Assembly**

- 1. Inner border. Sew (2) 2" x 62 ½" *Fabric A* strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 2" x 52 ½" *Fabric A* strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
- 2. Outer border. Sew (2) 3 ½" x 65 ½" *Fabric B* strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 3 ½" x 58 ½" *Fabric B* strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.



## **Finishing**

- 1. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
- 2. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
- 3. Bind to complete the quilt.
