

Carol Doak Retreat Supply List

We will provide you with the following:

- Full size irons & ironing stations
- Small trash bags for fabric scraps
- Cutting stations

You need to bring:

- Basic Sewing Supplies:
 - Small scissors and thread snips or <u>Curved Pointed Snips</u> (Scissors cannot be over 4" blade length if traveling by air)
 - o Rotary cutter, spare blades
 - o Seam ripper
- Flat-headed flower pins
 - Rotating mat (14" x 14") or
 Small cutting mat (14" x 14") or larger or a Cut 'n Press
 - o 6"x 12" and 6" x 6" rotary ruler
- 6" Add-a-Quarter ruler
- Postcard
- Stick on note pad (2" x 2")
- Styrofoam Tray or paper plates to organize cut fabric

- Small personal craft iron –
 Maximum 400W (Oliso miniirons are prohibited)
- Small ironing surface to have next to your machine if you are bringing a small craft Iron
- Optional but recommended items:
 - Quart and gallon size baggies for unfinished pieces
 - A task light (Ott-light type tabletop lamp)

Sewing Machine:

Please bring your sewing machine equipped with an open-toe presser foot, 90/14 needles and grey thread that will work for most color combinations. *If you are renting a Bernina 475 QE (if available) from Stitch' Heaven we can provide you with a #20 open-toe presser foot and a neutral beige thread.

Quilt Specific Supplies

- Select four- or five-star blocks from Carol's book, <u>60 Fabulous Paper-Pieced</u>
 <u>Stars.</u>
- Print or copy 5 copies of the foundations for each star block at 100% on <u>Carol</u>
 <u>Doak Foundation Paper</u>. (Making 1 extra in case of a mistake.)
- Bring a selection of fat quarters for the background areas of the star blocks and other design elements. 2 1/2" strips and larger work well for the design elements in the stars.
