QUILT ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM



Finished Quilt Size: 72" square

FINISHING

- 1. Cut batting and backing 6" larger than top on all sides.
- 2. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind using (8) $2-1/4" \times WOF \mathbf{R}$ strips.





S COLOR THEORY 9806-09 Geo Bloom White 1-3/8 Yds

(16) 2-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (16) 2-1/2" x 18-1/2" pieces and (16) 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" pieces





1-3/8 Yds (16) 2-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (16) 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" pieces, (32) 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" pieces and (16) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces

Backing: 4-3/8 yards; 78" square piece of batting

BLOCK #1 ASSEMBLY

- 1. Sew 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" **T** pieces to opposite sides of (1) 6-1/2" H square. Sew 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" T pieces to the top and bottom.
- 2. Sew 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" H pieces to opposite sides the unit from step 1. Sew 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" **H** pieces to the top and bottom.
- 3. Sew 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" **S** pieces to opposite sides of the unit from step 2. Sew 2-1/2" x 18-1/2" S pieces to the top and bottom to complete Block #1.
- 4. In the same way, repeat steps 1-3 using Fabrics A, B, E, F, G, K, and L for the colored strips for a total of (8) #1 Blocks.





BLOCK #2 ASSEMBLY

- 1. Sew 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" **O** pieces to opposite sides of (1) 6-1/2" **Q** square. Sew 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" O pieces to the top and bottom.
- 2. Sew 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" **T** pieces to opposite sides the unit from step 1. Sew 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" T pieces to the top and bottom.
- 3. Sew 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" **O** pieces to opposite sides of the unit from step 2. Sew 2-1/2" x 18-1/2" O pieces to the top and bottom to complete Block #2.
- 4. In the same way, repeat steps 1-3 using Fabrics C, D, I, J, M, N, and P for the colored strips for a total of (8) #2 Blocks.

OUILT ASSEMBLY

- 1. Referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram, lay out blocks into (4) rows of (4) block each, alternating #1 and #2 blocks as shown.
- 2. Sew the blocks into rows and join the rows to complete the guilt top.
