



These are just suggestions. Depending on your goals for the retreat you may pack differently. This list can help you not forget the most important things and is a great place to start.

If you do need to rent a sewing machine, we have them available for \$50 plus tax (one time charge per retreat).

You need to bring:

- Basic Sewing Supplies:
 - Sewing Machine (in well working order)
 - Extra sewing machine needles
 - Scissors
 - Rotary cutter
 - Thread
 - Spare blades
 - Seam ripper
 - Your favorite pins
 - Cutting mat
 - Rulers
 - Marking pens and/or pencils for light and dark fabrics
- Optional – but recommended items:
 - Quart and gallon size baggies for unfinished pieces
 - A task light (Ott-light type tabletop lamp)
 - Small personal craft iron – Maximum 400W (Oliso mini-irons are prohibited)
 - Small ironing surface to have next to your machine if you are bringing a small craft Iron
 - Small spray bottle

A swap table will be provided at the retreat for all who are interested. When was the last time you really cleaned your sewing area, getting ready for a retreat is a good time to find items you have double of, sewing items you thought you would like but once home did not like them? If you have extra rulers, scissors, etc. bring such items and place them on the swap table for someone to enjoy. Fabric scraps.

**As always, the only rules are that you take back anything of your own that is left on the table at the end of retreat.

Additional Information:

Don't forget to pack your personal toiletries, comfy clothes, snacks, show and tell projects or pictures, stuff for the swap table, extra blanket if you get cold at night.
