



# Alaska Legacy Quilting Voyage 2024 Supply List

## We will provide you with the following:

- Bernina sewing machine
- Quarter-inch foot
- Neutral cotton thread for class
- Bobbins
- Full size irons
- Small trash bags for fabric scraps
- Power cords
- Sail 'n Sew Kits for those who purchased the pre-cut kits.

## You need to bring:

- Basic Sewing Supplies:
  - Small scissors and/or thread snips. Scissors cannot be over 4" blade length
  - Rotary cutter with fresh blades
  - Seam ripper and seam roller
  - Stiletto or Purple Thang
  - Your favorite pins and pin cushion
  - Small cutting mat (18" x 24" is recommended) or a Cut 'n Press
  - Basic rulers: 6" x 12" or your favorite size
  - Marking pens and/or pencils for light and dark fabrics
- Optional – but recommended items:
  - Quart and gallon size baggies for unfinished pieces
  - Mini rotating cutting mat
  - A task light (Ott-light type tabletop lamp)
  - Small personal craft iron – Maximum 420W. Oliso mini-irons are prohibited
  - Small ironing surface to have next to your machine if you are bringing a small craft Iron
  - Small spray bottle to provide moisture for our dry irons

## Quilt specific supplies:

*You must bring these quilt specific tools in order to successfully complete your quilt top. These tools are NOT included in any SNS kit*

- **Double T**
  - 6.5" SQUARE RULER, [Creative Grids](#) will be helpful
- **Civil War Puzzle**
  - 6.5" SQUARE RULER, [Creative Grids](#) or Quilters Select strongly recommended
  - [BLOC-LOC Half Square Triangle Ruler](#)—to cut at least 3.5"HST. I prefer 4.5" or larger size

## Required:

If you did not purchase a Sail' n Sew kit, patterns and/or books are required for each project. You will need to purchase the pattern prior to the cruise, follow all of the cutting instructions in the pattern, and bring your fabrics pre-cut to class. Patterns and/or books are available on our website. We will not have extras in the classroom. Please note there will be no store with supplies onboard.
