





Almas Poncho

SIZE

Extra Small/Small (Medium/Large, 1X/2X, 3X/4X)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Lower Circumference: 54 (64, 74, 841/4)"

Length: 23½"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Deluxe DK Tweed Superwash* (90% superwash wool, 7% acrylic, 3% viscose; 100g/284 yds)

- 410 Porcelain (MC) 3 (4, 5, 5) skeins
- 405 Pine (CC1) 1 skein, all sizes
- 406 Aegean (CC2 1 skein, all sizes

Needles: US Size 6 (4 mm) 16" & 24" circular or size needed to obtain gauge US Size 5 (3.75 mm) 16" & 24" circular, US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 24" circular

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE

19 sts x 25 rows = 4" in St st using US Size 6

19 sts x 23 rows = 4" in stranded knitting using US Size 7

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

PATTERN NOTES

With just a touch of stranded knitting, this project is a nice introduction to this method of changing colors in your work. This short poncho or capelet is knit seamlessly in the round from the top down. It can act as a shoulder/bust warmer for a brisk walk in the woods, or can be scrunched up and worn as a cowl paired with your favorite winter coat.

STITCH GUIDE

K2, P2 Ribbing

(multiple of 4 sts)

Rnd 1: * K2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

PONCHO

With US Size 5 16" circ ndl, cast on 120 (128, 132, 140) sts. PM and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

Collar

Work in K2, P2 Ribbing for 4".

Main Body

Switch to US Size 6 16" circ ndl. Knit 1 rnd.

Extra Small/Small (Medium/Large) Sizes only:

Inc rnd: * K3 (2), m1; rep from * to end – 40 (64) sts inc'd, 160 (192) sts.

1X/2X Size only:

Inc rnd: [M1, k2] 20 times, [m1, k1] 51 times, [m1, k2] 20 times, m1, k1 – 92 sts inc'd, 224 sts.

3X/4X Size only:

Inc rnd: [M1, k2] 12 times, [m1, k1] 91 times, [m1, k2] 12 times, m1, k1 – 116 sts inc'd, 256 sts.

All Sizes:

Switch to longer Size 6 ndl. Knit 11 rnds. Switch to US Size 7 ndl. Work Rnds 1-13 of Diamonds chart . Patt will be repeated 20 (24, 28, 32) times across each rnd. After Rnd 13 of chart, switch to MC and US Size 6 ndl. Knit 2 rnds.

Increase Section

Inc rnd 1: * M1, k5 (4, 4, 4); rep from * to end -32 (48, 56, 64) sts inc'd, 192 (240, 280, 320) sts. Knit 7 rnds.

Inc rnd 2: * M1, k6 (6, 7, 8); rep from * to end -32 (40, 40, 40) sts inc'd, 224 (280, 320, 360) sts. Knit 7 rnds.

Inc rnd 3: KO (16, 0, 0), * m1, k7 (10, 10, 9); rep from * to end - 32 (24, 32, 40) sts inc'd, 256 (304, 352, 400) sts.

Work even in St st until piece meas 19½" from cast-on edge.

Switch to US Size 7 24" circ ndl. Work Rnds 1-13 of Diamonds chart. Patt wil be repeated 32 (38, 44, 50) times across each rnd. After Rnd 13 of chart, switch to MC and US Size 6 ndl. Knit 10 rnds.

Hem

Switch to US Size 5 (3.75 mm) ndl. Work in K2, P2 Ribbing for 5 rnds. Bind off all sts loosely in patt.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block to finished measurements.




