



Pattern Collection: Accessories

SIZES

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 9½"

Length: 70" (excluding fringe)

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Bamboo Bloom*

Handpaints (48% rayon from bamboo, 44% wool, 8% acrylic; 100g/154 yds)

- 325 Steven Belious (C1) – 1 skein

Universal Yarn *Uptown Bulky* (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 100g/87 yds)

- 425 Turquoise (C2) – 2 skeins

Needles: US Size 17 (12 mm) straight *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, US Size K-10½ (6.5 mm) crochet hook (for attaching fringe)

GAUGE

8 sts x 12 rows = 4" in garter st with 1 strand of each yarn held together

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit. Relax. Smile. Repeat!

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STITCH GUIDE

Double Wrap Pattern

(any number of sts)

Rows 1-4: Knit.

Row 5: K1 * knit, wrapping the yarn twice around the ndl for ea st; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 6: K1 * knit, dropping the extra wrap from the prev row; rep from * to last st, k1.

Rep Rows 1-6 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

This scarf is worked from one end to the other widthwise with both yarns held together as one throughout.

SCARF

With C1 and C2 held tog, cast on 17 sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Beg Double Wrap patt, work 25 patt reps (150 rows total) or until piece meas approx. 68". Work 5 rows even in garter st, loosely bind off kwise.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends, wash and block to Finished Measurements.

Fringe

Cut 24, 16" pieces of yarn ea in C1 and C2 (48 strands total). Holding 1 strand of C1 and C2 tog as one group of fringe, attach each group to cast-on and bind off edge of scarf, spaced approx. ¼" apart. Trim ends.
