## SIZE

One size fits all

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS
Width: 52"
Length: 25"

## MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Revolutions (57\% acrylic, 15\% nylon, 10\% wool, 10\% alpaca, 8\% mohair; 200g/612 yds)

- 101 Port - 2 skeins

Needles: US Size 10 ( 6 mm ) 24" circular or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE
12 sts $\times 18$ rows $=4$ " in Ribbing patt Save time, check your gauge.

## Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

## PATTERN NOTES

Enjoy the slow color shift of Revolutions in this one-size poncho. The neck opening is set asymmetrically, giving an otherwise simple piece just a little something special. It can be worn with ribbing going either vertically, horizontally, or even at an angle.

## STITCH GUIDE

Ribbing
(multiple of 4 sts +1 )
Row 1 (RS): K2, * p1, k3; rep from * to last 3 sts, p1, k2.
Row 2 (WS): * P1, k3; rep from * to last st, p1.
Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

## PONCHO

Cast on 153 sts Work in Ribbing patt until piece meas 18 ", ending with WS row.

## Separate Front and Back

Row 1 (RS): Work in patt over 76 sts Front sts, m1, place rem 77 Back sts on holder. Work even in patt over 77 Front sts until piece meas 34 " from separation. Bind off all sts. Return Back sts to ndl. Work even in patt over 77 Back sts until piece meas 34 " from separation. Bind off all sts.

## FINISHING

Block piece to finished measurements. Sew Front and Back together at shoulder for $25^{\prime \prime}$, leaving 9" unsewn for Neck opening. Weave in ends and block.
