





Bienne Tee

SIZES

Extra Small (Small, Medium, Large, 1X, 2X)

Note: Tee is intended to fit with up to 6-8 inches of positive ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: 37¾ (40¾, 44¼, 47¾, 50¾, 54¼)"

MATERIALS

Fibra Natura *Flax Lace* (100% linen; 547 yds/100g)

• 101 Taupe – 2 (2, 3, 3, 3, 3) hanks

Needles: US Size 3 (3.25 mm) straight, 16" circular (for neck edging) *or size* needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, cable needle (cn), stitch holders

GAUGE

27 sts x 38 rows = 4" in Cables and Lace

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

PATTERN NOTES

This layering tee is knit from the bottom up. Front and back are knit separately and seamed together.

STITCH GUIDE

3x3 Right Cross (RC): SI next 3 sts to cn and hold in back, k3 from left ndl, k3 from cn.

K2, P2 Ribbing

(multiple of 4 sts + 2)

Row 1 (RS): * K2, p2; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2. Row 2 (WS): * P2, k2; rep from * to last 2 st, p2. Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

Cables and Lace

(multiple of 11 sts + 9)

Row 1 (RS): K2, * yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k6; rep from * to last 7 sts, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2.

WS Rows 2-8: Purl.

Row 3: K2, * k1, yo, sl 1-k2tog-psso, yo, k1, 3x3 RC; rep from * to last 7 sts, k1, yo, sl 1-k2tog-psso, yo, k3.

Row 5: K2, * yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k6; rep from * to last 7 sts, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2.

Row 7: K2, * k1, yo, sl 1-k2tog-psso, yo, k7; rep from * to last 7 sts, k1, yo, sl 1-k2tog-psso, yo, k3. Rep Rows 1-8 for patt.

BACK

Cast on 130 (138, 150, 162, 174, 182) sts. Work in K2, P2 Ribbing until piece meas $1\frac{3}{4}$ " from cast-on edge, ending with a WS row, and inc'ing 0 (3, 2, 1, 0, 3) sts evenly on last row – 130 (141, 152, 163, 174, 185) sts. Beg with RS Row 1, work in Cables and Lace patt until piece meas 15 (14½, 14½, 14, 14, 13½)", ending with WS row.

Increase For Sleeves

Cast on 17 sts at beg of next 2 rows – 164 (175, 186, 197, 208, 219) sts. Work even in patt until piece meas $4\frac{1}{4}$ ($4\frac{1}{2}$, 5, $5\frac{1}{2}$, $6\frac{1}{4}$)" from Sleeve cast-on, ending with WS row.

Separate Left and Right Sides

Row 1 (RS): Work in patt over 47 (52, 57, 62, 67, 72) sts, attach new ball of yarn and bind off center 70 (71, 72, 73, 74, 75) sts, work in patt over rem 47 (52, 57, 62, 67, 72) sts. Working both sides at once, cont in patt until piece meas 6 (6 ½,

7, 7 ½, 8, 8 ½)" from Sleeve cast-on, ending with WS row. Place each set of live sts on a separate holder, break yarn.

FRONT

Work as for Back but do not break yarn. Join shoulder sts to Back using 3-ndl bind-off.

FINISHING

Block piece to finished measurements.


Neck Edging

With RS facing and circ ndl, pick up and knit 192 (194, 196, 198, 200, 202) sts evenly around Neck. PM and join to work in the rnd. Purl 1 rnd, knit 1 rnd, purl 1 rnd. Bind off all sts kwise over the next rnd.

Sleeve Edging

With RS facing, pick up and knit 82 (86, 94, 102, 106, 114) sts evenly along sides of Sleeve. Work in K2, P2 Ribbing for 4 rows. Bind off all sts in patt over the next row.

Sew Sleeve and side seams. Weave in ends.


