DIFFICULTY

Intermediate

SIZES

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 7" Length: 59"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Noelle* (29% polyester, 26% merino wool, 26% baby alpaca , 19% nylon; 50g/208 yds)

• 304 Calypso - 3 balls

Hook: US Size H/8 (5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

US Size P/Q (15 mm) for Broomstick

Lace

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers

GAUGE

17 sts x 11½ rows = 4" in Half Double Crochet (hdc) with smaller hook Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

This lovely scarf demonstrates that there is elegance in simplicity. Swirls of Broomstick Lace dance up the edges of this accessory to meet with an understated half double crochet stitch that showcases the sparkle of Noelle.

This scarf is worked flat in two separate pieces, beginning at the ends and working towards the center. The two pieces are joined at the center with a whipstitch seam.

STITCH GUIDE

Broomstick Lace Stitch

This stitch pattern is created over a sequence of two rows, using a multiple of 5 stitches.

Row 1 (RS): Working left to right, pull current lp up and place on base of larger hk (counts as 1st lp), *insert smaller hk into next st, yo, pull up a lp, transfer lp to base of larger hk; rep from * across row, do not turn.

Row 2 (RS) Working right to left, carefully slide the first 5 lps off of the larger hk onto smaller hk, yo, draw through 5 lps, ch 1, 5 sc through all lps at the same time, * carefully slide the next 5 lps off of base of larger hk onto smaller hk, 5 sc through lps; rep from * across, turn.

Broomstick Lace Pattern

(ch a multiple of 5 + 1)

Set-up Row (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hk and each st across, do not turn.

Rows 1-2 (RS): Work Broomstick Lace Stitch, turn.

Row 3 (WS): Ch 1, sc in 1st and each st across, turn.

Row 4 (RS): Rep Row 3. Rep Rows 1-4 for Pattern.

PATTERN BEGINS

First Half

Ch 31.

Set-up Row (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hk and each st across, do not turn, - 30 sts.

Rows 1-20: Work Rows 1-4 of Broomstick Lace Pattern, 5 times. There will be 6 groups of Broomstick Lace across each Row 1 of pattern repeat.

Rows 21-84: Ch 2 (counts as st here and throughout), hdc in next and each st across, turn - 30 hdc.

Fasten off.

Second Half

Rep First Half instructions but leave a long tail for seaming after fastening off.

FINISHING

Assembly

Holding pieces with RS together, and last row of each half parallel, whipstitch through both layers to join.

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.




